



FOX 10 Xtra News airs 1 hour of live news each weekday @ 7PM. In addition, the station produces a 2 hour streaming live news show each weekday @ 10AM, "FOX 10 News Now."

This report highlights the issues that were of greatest importance during the months of July, August, and September of 2018.

On the chart that follows we list the stories we covered in these topic areas including the date, specific newscast and on-air format. Here is a key to estimate how much time we allocated to each story:

RDR = reader

Anchor reads script with no video. Typically 20 seconds

VO = anchor voice-over

Anchor reads script with video. Typically 20-30 seconds

VOSOT = anchor voice-over/"sound on tape"

Anchor reads script with video. Story includes sound bite from interview subject.  
Usually 45 seconds

LIVE VO = live voice over

Reporter live in the studio or field with extended video and information. Typically 1 minute

LIVE VOSOT = live voice over/"sound on tape"

Reporter live in the studio or field with extended video and sound bite from interview subject. Usually 1 minute, 45 seconds

PKG = reporter package

A self-contained story narrated by an anchor or reporter  
An anchor usually introduces the story  
Including anchor introductions, stories typically run 1 minute, 30 seconds

LIVE PKG = live reporter including reporter package

Same as PKG above, except a reporter introduces the story live from the scene

7/31/18	7PM	VO	OFFICIALS FACE LAWMAKER QUESTIONS ON THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION'S POLICY OF SEPARATING CHILDREN AT THE BORDER. THE HEARING COMES AMID REPORTS OF ABUSE AT GOVERNMENT DETENTION FACILITIES. PRESIDENT TRUMP STAYING COMMITTED IN HIS DEMAND FOR TOUGH BORDER SECURITY, TWEETING ABOUT MEXICO'S MURDER RATE TO BACK-UP HIS CALLS AFTER THREATENING TO SHUT DOWN THE GOVERNMENT IF DEMOCRATS DO NOT APPROVE HIS IMMIGRATION PROPOSALS. BUT WAS OFFICIALLY APPOINTED TODAY BY CUSTOMS AND BORDER PATROL. ONLY ABOUT FIVE PERCENT OF THE BORDER PATROL'S NEARLY 20-THOUSAND AGENTS ARE WOMEN. SHE JOINED THE BORDER PATROL IN 1995. AS AN AGENT IN DOUGLAS, ARIZONA AND WORKED IN TOP MANAGEMENT POSITIONS IN EL PASO, AND EL CENTRO, CALIFORNIA.
9/27/18	7PV	VO	IN THE BORDER BATTLE:, NEARLY 270 ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS WERE DETAINED IN THE LAST TWO DAYS IN SOUTHERN ARIZONA. BORDER PATROL AGENTS FOUND 164 PEOPLE ON TUESDAY AND ANOTHER 100 ILLEGAL BORDER-CROSSERS ON WEDNESDAY. THEY INCLUDED PEOPLE FROM GUATEMALA, HONDURAS AND EL SALVADOR., RANGING IN AGE FROM 11-MONTHS TO 59-YEARS-OLD.

THERE THEY WILL RACE THEIR POD AGAINST TEAMS FROM ACROSS THE WORLD. HYPERLOOP IS A HIGH-SPEED TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM THAT SENDS PODS THROUGH A TUBE. THE TEAM IS ONE OF 20 FINALISTS SELECTED ON THEIR DESIGNS. THEY WILL OFFICIALLY SHOW OF THEIR POD NEXT WEEK.
7/6/18	7PM	LIVEPKG	YOU MAY NOT KNOW THAT PHOENIX IS ONE OF THE NATION'S WORST AREAS WHEN IT COMES TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING. A LOCAL HOSPITAL SYSTEM IS HOPING TO PULL MORE VICTIMS OFF THE STREETS AND CRACK DOWN ON THIS EPIDEMIC. FOX 10'S REPORTER, JENNIFER AUH HAD A LIVE STORY OF ONE SURVIVOR. THIS SURVIVOR YOU'RE ABOUT TO MEET WAS TRAFFICKED WHEN SHE WAS ONLY 13 AND SHE WAS IMPREGNATED BY HER TRAFFICKER WHEN SHE WAS 14. SHE TALKED ABOUT HOW SHE WAS SUCKED INTO THIS LIFESTYLE BECAUSE SHE THOUGHT IT WAS HER ONLY OPTION. "Coerced into the life, didn't understand what I was walking into. Didn't have any resources. Didn't have family structure to fall back on, and this guy was family to me." WITH NO FAMILY TO TURN TO, SHANNA PARKER SAYS SHE ONCE LOOKED FOR LOVE AND PROTECTION, SOMEWHERE ELSE. "I had a child with him, I got pregnant at 14, and had a child so I envisioned this life together forever, just like everyone else did." BUT SOON THINGS TOOK A TURN, "He was extremely vicious, and would often beat you until you were unconscious." AND THEN THINGS GOT EVEN WORSE, "There were two other women who were trafficked with me for all of those years, and when I was 18 years old, he murdered one of the women." THAT WAS HOW SHANNA'S LIFE WITH HER TRAFFICKER ENDED, NOT BECAUSE SHE WAS SAVED, BUT THROUGH A DOUBLE MURDER TRIAL. "A lot of professionals still don't yet understand what human trafficking really means." WITH HUMAN TRAFFICKING IS A VIOLENT INDUSTRY, WITH MANY VICTIMS. IN FACT ONE STUDY SHOWS 88 PERCENT OF THEM USUALLY ENCOUNTER A HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL, BUT WEREN'T PROPERLY IDENTIFIED."Whether a healthcare system is prepared or not, victims and survivors are encountering healthcare professionals". SO DIGNITY HEALTHCARE SAYS THEY WANT TO EDUCATE THEIR STAFF ABOUT HUMAN TRAFFICKING, AND HOW TO RESPOND APPROPRIATELY TO THE SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS. "Human trafficking often overlaps with other forms of violence, so if you're caring for a patient who you think may be a victim of domestic violence or sexual assault or child abuse, or elder abuse, it should be a consideration, that human trafficking could be a factor as well."THIS TRAINING PROGRAM IS TAKING PLACE AT 40 DIGNITY HEALTH HOSPITALS ACROSS THREE STATES, INCLUDING ARIZONA. SOME SIGNS THESE HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS ARE BEING TRAINED TO LOOK OUT FOR ARE, FREQUENT TEENAGE RUNAWAYS SHOWING UP WITH SUSPICIOUSLY EXPENSIVE ITEMS, AN UNDERAGED GIRL HAVING AN OLDER CONTROLLING BOYFRIEND AND IF THEY'RE USING SOME SORT OF SLANG LANGUAGE.
7/6/18	7PM	VOSOT	SEVERE HEAT ACROSS THE VALLEY TODAY AS WE TIED A RECORD AT 114 DEGREES. UNFORTUNATELY, IT WAS ALSO THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL FOR MANY VALLEY KIDS. WHILE SOME SCHOOLS ARE CUTTING BACK ON RECESS - OTHERS ARE BRINGING RECESS INDOORS. BUT ONE TEACHER SAYS STAYING INDOORS CAN STILL BE A GOOD WORKOUT. "Keeping kids active in general is important and them active means that they're healthy. Just because we're inside doesn't mean they can't get that activity." ALL OF THE SCHOOLS WITHIN THE CREIGHTON SCHOOL DISTRICT HAD RECESS INDOORS TODAY.

OF TRANSPORTATION SAYS PEOPLE ARE NOW TRYING TO SELL ANSWERS TO THE WRITTEN TEST ON SOCIAL MEDIA. THE THING IS MOST OF THAT INFORMATION IS ALREADY AVAILABLE ON ADOT'S WEBSITE FOR FREE. IN FACT, THE ARIZONA MOTOR VEHICLE DIVISION HAS OFFERED FREE ONLINE PRACTICE TESTS FOR YEARS SO THAT PEOPLE CAN SEE THE QUESTIONS THAT MAY COME UP DURING THE ACTUAL EXAM. ANOTHER THING THEY SAY TO LOOK OUT FOR... COPYCAT WEBSITES THAT COULD END UP CHARGING YOU MUCH LARGER FEES THAN THE MVD WOULD.
8/8/18	7PM	VOSOT	IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR AGAIN, KIDS AROUND THE VALLEY ARE HEADING BACK TO SCHOOL AND THE PHOENIX SUNS WANT TO MAKE SURE THEY GET AHEAD OF THE GAME. MEMBERS OF THE SUNS AND MERCURY TOOK TIME OFF THE COURT TO DELIVER BACKPACKS FILLED WITH ALL SORTS OF SCHOOL SUPPLIES TO DAVID CROCKET ELEMENTARY SCHOOL. STEVEN HUNTER, FORMER SUNS PLAYER & COMMUNITY AMBASSADOR SAID, "This school is very much needed and as far as you know, giving back these backpacks so it's only right that we come back and do this thing for the kids." STARTING TODAY - PHOENIX CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL WILL STAFF TWO FULL TIME MUSIC THERAPISTS. OUR REPORTER, COURTNEY GRIFFIN SPOKE WITH ONE VALLEY FAMILY SUPPORTING THE PROGRAM. TODAY CARTER JOHNSON IS 2 YEARS OLD. HE'S ALREADY COME A LONG WAY FROM HIS DAY OF BIRTH. "He is learning how to sit up more on his own.. for the first time this past week". ALL JULE RENATO, THE MUSIC THERAPIST HERE AT PCH WOULD SEE CARTER THREE TIMES A WEEK WHEN HE WAS A PATIENT AT THE HOSPITAL. SHE SAYS ON GOOD DAYS HE WOULD INTERACT WITH HER-- ON ROUGH DAYS PRIOR TO SURGERY HE COULDN'T DO MUCH PHYSICALLY BUT THE MUSIC STILL MADE A BIG IMPACT ON HIM. "One of the coolest things about what it is that you can see on the monitor his heart rate coming down-- medical team being able to uh take a breath .. okay he's good right now." IT IS AN INCREDIBLE FEAT, RELAXING THE MIND, BODY AND SPIRIT, WHILE ALSO HELPING OUT MOM. "I wish there was more of it, my daughter didn't have it, I didn't know what to do with myself because I never left the bed side". IT'S A UNIQUE POSITION THAT PHOENIX CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL STARTED OFFERING A YEAR AGO AND LISA SAYS IT MADE A HUGE DIFFERENCE DURING THE TIME SHE SPENT AT PCH. "There were times she would just hum, as she did it I would have loved to have her there every day."

9/25/18	7PM	VO	THREE VALLEY HIGH SCHOOLS ON ALERT TODAY AFTER SOCIAL MEDIA THREATS ARE MADE. THE LATEST HAPPENING AT MCCLINTOCK HIGH SCHOOL. PARENTS SAY THEY RECEIVED A NOTIFICATION THAT A THREAT WAS MADE THIS MORNING. THIS COMES AFTER AN OVERNIGHT THREAT WAS MADE TO MARICOPA HIGH SCHOOL, PRINCIPAL BRIAN WINTER SAYS THE THREAT IS SIMILAR TO A RECENT ONE IN A NEARBY DISTRICT. BECAUSE OF THAT, SCHOOL OFFICIALS INCREASED SECURITY AROUND THE CAMPUS. STUDENTS WHO CHOSE TO STAY HOME HAD EXCUSED ABSENCES. AS A PRECAUTION, STUDENTS WERE ASKED TO LEAVE THEIR BACKPACKS AT HOME. THE SAME POLICY WAS IN EFFECT AT MOUNTAIN POINTE HIGH SCHOOL. A SOCIAL MEDIA THREAT AGAINST THE SCHOOL SURFACED SUNDAY NIGHT AND POLICE NOW SAY THEY HAVE A STRONG LEAD IN THIS CASE AND ARE CURRENTLY ACTIVELY FOLLOWING UP ON THEM. THERE WAS EXTRA SECURITY ON CAMPUS...BUT YESTERDAY MANY PARENTS KEPT THEIR KIDS HOME FOR THE DAY.
9/25/18	7PM	PKG	FIRST IT WAS HELICOPTER PARENTS, MOMS AND DADS WHO PAY A LITTLE TOO MUCH ATTENTION TO THEIR KIDS LIFE AND PROBLEMS. NOW THERE IS A NEW TERM HITTING PARENTING CIRCLES, LAWN MOWER PARENTS. BY NOW WE'VE ALL HEARD OF HELICOPTER PARENTS, A LABEL SO MAINSTREAM IT'S NOW INCLUDED IN THE DICTIONARY. ZIEGLER says: "And people are just astonished by this and really its these young professionals! don't have the skills to advocate for themselves. It's a real problem." EMILY O'CONNEL HAS ALSO SEEN IT. O'CONNELL says: "I'm not a fan of that."BUT EVEN THIS MOTHER OF TWO SAYS THE LINE BETWEEN APPROPRIATE INTERFERENCE AND TOO MUCH CAN SOMETIMES BE DIFFICULT TO GAUGE. O'CONNELL says: "It's really hard to know when to step in but I feel like they have to fight their own battles." FIGHT THEIR OWN BATTLES AND MOW THEIR OWN LAWNS IS SOUND ADVICE THAT WILL MAKE OUR KIDS THAT MUCH STRONGER IN THE LONG RUN. ZIEGLER says: "Children are children. Our job is to teach them."

Theresa James, City of Tempe Housing Supervisor: When we did our last home a street count, we counted about 300 individuals on the street and a portion of those are veterans. We know they move across the county so we know they may not all be in Tempe but we know overall there's a large number out there. In the state, there as many as 700 homeless veterans, according to the Arizona Department of economic security. Romaldo "Ro" Gonzalez, Marine Corps veteran: Myself when I've been homeless, I was too proud to ask. I was like I'll figure it out I'll figure it out. Ro isn't a part of his program. He's already receiving help through Valor on Eighth. But he says he's so relieved the city is looking at more options for veterans to get help. He would still be homeless too, but now has a job and a place he can call home. This latest program called HUD-VASH IS ALL PART OF A LARGER FEDERAL PROGRAM A NATIONWIDE EFFORT TO HELP VETERANS OVERCOME HOMELESSNESS. AND THERE ARE INCENTIVES FOR LANDLORDS, SUCH AS MONTHLY RENT BEING PAID DIRECTLY THROUGH THE LOCAL HOUSING AUTHORITY, so they don't have to worry about rent coming in late. Ro's message to the landlords out there in Tempe everyone deserves a second chance, especially those who served our country. Having that place available and stuff like that, they at least deserve that. THE NEW HUD-VASH PROGRAM IN TEMPE WILL START WITH HELPING 10 VETERAN FAMILIES, BUT COULD BE EXPANDED. Landlords who are interested in participating can also contact the city of Tempe's housing department.
