



FOX 10 Xtra News airs 1 hour of live news each weekday @ 7PM. In addition, the station produces a 2 hour streaming live news show each weekday @ 10AM, "FOX 10 News Now."

This report highlights the issues that were of greatest importance during the months of October, November, and December of 2018.

On the chart that follows we list the stories we covered in these topic areas including the date, specific newscast and on-air format. Here is a key to estimate how much time we allocated to each story:

RDR = reader

Anchor reads script with no video. Typically 20 seconds

VO = anchor voice-over

Anchor reads script with video. Typically 20-30 seconds

VOSOT = anchor voice-over/"sound on tape"

Anchor reads script with video. Story includes sound bite from interview subject. Usually 45 seconds

LIVE VO = live voice over

Reporter live in the studio or field with extended video and information. Typically 1 minute

LIVE VOSOT = live voice over/"sound on tape"

Reporter live in the studio or field with extended video and sound bite from interview subject. Usually 1 minute, 45 seconds

PKG = reporter package

A self-contained story narrated by an anchor or reporter

An anchor usually introduces the story

Including anchor introductions, stories typically run 1 minute, 30 seconds

LIVE PKG = live reporter including reporter package

Same as PKG above, except a reporter introduces the story live from the scene

THEY'VE BEEN RELEASED BY IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT BECAUSE THE AGENCY SAYS IT DOESN'T HAVE THE CAPACITY TO HANDLE THE HIGH NUMBER OF MIGRANT FAMILIES ARRIVING AT THE SOUTHERN BORDER WITH MEXICO. DUE TO RESTRICTIONS ICE CANNOT KEEP THESE Families in custody past a certain point, so they had to release them, about 100 asylum Seekers. They dropped them off at Shadow Rock United Church of Christ in Phoenix late Monday night. Shadow Rock United Church of Christ, "WEVE HOSTED IMMIGRANTS BEFORE USUALLY IN SMALLER GROUPS OF ABOUT 10 TO 30 WAS THE MOST WEVE TAKEN IN THIS IS ALOT OF PEOPLE MUCH BIGGER OPERATION ALOT MORE VOLUNTEERS ON HAND DOING MEALS AND LINENS AND EVERYTHING." Spencer says the church has been heartened by themany volunteers who have shown up to help with the families.They are disheartened by the negative comments and pushback some have directed at the church for housing the immigrant families. On Fox 10's Facebook page some did post critical comments One man writing "Undocumented potential criminals." Another posted " Raid it, arrest them and deport them" Still another wrote " I don't understand why people dont see the problem here... you can't just walk into a country and stay... that is not a country."Spencer says the church is well aware of the criticism, but will stick to its core values. "WHEN YOU SEE A NEIGHBOR WHO NEEDS A PLACE TO SLEEP YOU OFFER THEM A BED. IF YOUR NEIGHBOR NEEDS A COAT YOU GIVE THEM A COAT . IF YOUR NEIGHBOR IS HUNGRY YOU GIVE THEM FOOD. ITS PRETTY SIMPLE TO US. " Spencer expects most of the families will move on in the next 24 hours. she says the travellers were relived to be in a safe place with food and a place to sleep. She expects they will move on in the next 24 hours.
10/26/18	9PM	VOSOT	A MILESTONE IN THE EFFORT TO BUILD A WALL BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND MEXICO. BORDER SECURITY FRONT AND CENTER AS THE FIRST SECTION OF PRESIDENT TRUMP'S BORDER WALL IS COMPLETED. SECRETARY OF HOMELAND SECURITY VISITED THE SITE TODAY IN CALIFORNIA'S EL CENTRO SECTOR. SHE SAYS THE 2 AND A HALF MILES LONG, 30 FOOT HIGH WALL IS A MAJOR STEP IN THE COMMITMENT TO SECURE OUR BORDERS. NIELSEN says: "Let me be clear, walls work. That's not my opinion. It's not a tag line. It's not a political statement. It's a fact. We've seen the success for walls in El Paso, in Yuma, in San Diego and in the past right here in the El Centro sector." 10/26/18	9PM	VOSOT	TONIGHT A CARAVAN OF CENTRAL AMERICAN MIGRANTS CONTINUING THEIR SLOW TREK THROUGH MEXICO, HEADING FOR THE U-S BORDER. THE WHITE HOUSE REPORTEDLY WEIGHING EXECUTIVE ACTION TO STOP THE MIGRANT CARAVAN AS PRESIDENT TRUMP SENDS EIGHT HUNDRED TROOPS TO OUR SOUTHERN BORDER THE SOLDIERS ARE EXPECTED TO OFFER LOGISTICAL SUPPORT. AN ESTIMATED FOUR THOUSAND MIGRANTS ARE NOW IN SOUTHERN MEXICO ABOUT ONE THOUSAND MILES FROM THE U-S MEXICO BORDER. MEANTIME, MILITIA GROUPS AND FAR-RIGHT ACTIVISTS ARE RAISING MONEY TO TRY TO STOP THE CARAVAN. THE UNITED STATES BORDER PATROL IS NOW WARNING TEXAS LAND-OWNERS TO BE ON THE LOOKOUT FOR ARMED U-S CIVILIANS ON THEIR PROPERTY. MORE THAN 700-THOUSAND PEOPLE ARE WAITING ON THEIR PROCESS TO BECOME A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES BUT EVER SINCE PRESIDENT TRUMP TOOK OFFICE THE LONG WAIT TIMES GREW. SOME IMMIGRANT ADVOCATES QUESTION IF THE DELAYS ARE AIMED AT KEEPING ANTI-TRUMP VOTERS FROM CASTING BALLOTS IN ELECTIONS. FOX NEWS CORRESPONDENT JENNIFER GRIFFIN HAS MORE FROM THE PENTAGON. THOUSANDS OF CENTRAL AMERICAN MIGRANTS REMAIN ABOUT 500 MILES FROM THE U-S BORDER IN SEVERAL CARAVANS BUT ON WEDNESDAY A BREAKAWAY GROUP OF SEVERAL HUNDRED, JUMPING A BORDER FENCE NEAR Tijuana. THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY SAYS THOSE WHO CROSS ILLEGALLY ARE INELIGIBLE FOR ASYLUM. BUT THE MIGRANTS SAY THEY'RE DETERMINED TO PRESS ON AND FIND A BETTER LIFE IN AMERICA. BRICENO says: (translated) "If Trump really wants to help Honduras, help us to work in the United States, even just for a short period of time, and then you can send us back." DEFENSE SECRETARY JIM MATTIS, VISITING THE BORDER TODAY, GETTING A FIRST-HAND LOOK AT THE 5-THOUSAND 9-HUNDRED U-S TROOPS NOW DEPLOYED IN THE AREA. MATTIS SAYS THEY'RE HELPING BORDER POLICE PREPARE FOR THE CARAVAN'S ARRIVAL AND DOESN'T ANTICIPATE TROOPS COMING INTO DIRECT CONTACT WITH MIGRANTS. MATTIS says: "the DOD - Department of Defense missions do not involve military personnel at this time directly participating in any law enforcement. 11/21/18	7PM	VO	A FEDERAL JUDGE ENDING A POLICY TODAY THAT SAYS ASYLUM SEEKERS CAN ONLY ENTER THE COUNTRY AT OFFICIAL BORDER CROSSINGS.L AWYERS SUING THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION HAVE ARGUED THAT ASYLUM SEEKERS MAY NOT BE ABLE TO LOCATE OFFICIAL BORDER CROSSINGS TO MAKE THEIR CLAIMS. THIS IS A MAJOR BLOW TO THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION, WHICH HAS CLAIMED THERE ARE CRIMINALS AMONG THE CARAVANS OF MIGRANTS. THE JUDGE'S ORDER WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL DECEMBER 19TH. LAWMAKERS AND THE FAMILY OF 7-YEAR-OLD JAKELIN CAAL ARE CALLING FOR AN INDEPENDENT INVESTIGATION AFTER THE YOUNG GIRL DIED WHILE IN THE CUSTODY OF U-S BORDER PATROL. JAKELIN AND HER FATHER WERE AMONG A GROUP OF MIGRANTS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY ON DECEMBER 6TH AT THE U-S BORDER NEAR NEW MEXICO. JUST HOURS AFTER BEING PLACED ON A BUS BY BORDER PATROL JAKELIN BEGAN VOMITING, SPIKED A TEMPERATURE OVER 105 DEGREES AND EVENTUALLY STOPPED BREATHING. SHE DIED ON DECEMBER 8TH AT AN EL PASO HOSPITAL. RUIZ says: "What caused the death? What could we've done differently to prevent the child from dying? And what can we learn from this experience so that we can prevent future case scenarios like this." U-S BORDER PATROL CLAIMS JAKELIN WAS MALNOURISHED AND HAD NOT HAD FOOD OR WATER FOR DAYS. BUT, HER FAMILY'S ATTORNEYS SAY THAT CLAIM IS FALSE. U-S CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION OFFICIALS HAVE SAID THEY ARE CONDUCTING AN INTERNAL INVESTIGATION INTO JAKELIN'S DEATH AND JAKELIN'S FAMILY WANTS TO KNOW IF BORDER PATROL OFFICIALS MET THE PROPER STANDARDS OF CARE FOR TAKING CHILDREN INTO CUSTODY. SOME LAWMAKERS SAYING BORDER PATROL AGENTS NEED TO BE BETTER EQUIPPED TO PROTECT THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF MIGRANTS. GREEN says: "I believe that we have to stand up. We've got to get better equipment. And we've got to understand that we're dealing with a humanitarian crisis." AUTHORITIES ARE CONDUCTING AN AUTOPSY TO DETERMINE JAKELIN'S CAUSE OF DEATH. THE RESULTS ARE EXPECTED SOME TIME NEXT WEEK
