#### Section I. Issues

This station (WRIL-FM) identifies the following significant issues germane to our listening audience this quarter.

- A. **Criminal activity** – This community deals with several criminal elements and should be kept updated on any dangers to the public.
- B. **Obituary announcements** - The area local paper is only publishing a paper four times a week underserving the area.
- C. **School ending safety** – parents often rely on this station for school information.
- D. **Summer offerings** –the public needs to be kept updated on what recreation and options there are in the community.
- E. **Drug usage prevention** – This community deals with drug overdoses more than many and treatment information is vital.
- F. **Outdoor safety** – listeners need to stay cautious while outside and need information on how to do that.

#### Section II. Station programs regarding issues.

This station (WRIL-FM) provides a daily programming which interacts with the listeners as well as informing them of the issues mentioned above.

- A. **Criminal activity** – during “Tradio” (Monday through Friday 9am – 10:30am) we acknowledge on air any dangers to the public (i.e. scams, criminal watches to look out for, wanted individuals)
- B. **Obituary announcements** – we provide seven-day-a-week announcements at fixed times 6am, 7am, 8am, and 12 noon for these vital notices to provide the public with those who have passed away.
- C. **School ending safety** – we air daily information during the “Tradio” program on what parents are to expect as school is coming to a close. We also interview school/college counselors to aid parents in making educational decision for their children
- D. **Summer offerings** – we regularly air information regarding venues and attractions offered in our community during “Tradio” and our community calendar which airs daily at approximately 1:30pm.
- E. **Drug usage prevention** – we often interview local law enforcement, clergy, and counselors regarding alternatives to drug usage.
- F. **Outdoor safety** – We regularly air interviews with law enforcement, including park rangers, to remind listeners of safety tips while outside.
