The new law lessens the economic incentive for immigrants to sneak across the border and to curb Arizona's role as the busiest illegal gateway into the country. Under the law, businesses that knowingly hire illegal immigrants could face a business license suspension lasting up to 10 days. Second-time violators would have their business licenses permanently revoked. Business groups challenged the law in court, saying it would poison Arizona's business climate and that cracking down on such hires was the sole province of the federal government.

Recession Watch: More and more economists are looking at all the bad news and saying recession seems to be inevitable. Job growth is faltering, consumer confidence plunging, there's a credit crunch and the worst housing slump in a quarter-century is growing. The latest survey by the National Association for Business Economics says 45 percent of the economists on its forecasting panel expect a recession this year. In September, only one in four economists was pessimistic enough to put the chance of a recession at 35 percent or higher. The survey shows that 55 percent still believe the country will be able to skate by without falling into an actual downturn. That's typically defined as two consecutive quarters of declines in the gross domestic output. All the analysts expect growth to slow considerably this year.

And they said that the resources in the Social Security trust fund will be depleted by 2041. The reserves in the Medicare trust fund that pays hospital benefits were projected to be wiped out by 2019.
