**WPNA 103.1 FM Programs Addressing Public and Community Issues**

During the third quarter of 2021, WPNA's bilingual (Polish/English) programming addressed the following issues of concern to the public:

1. *Morning with 103.1 FM* (July 9, 8:00 a.m., segment duration 4 min.)

*Issue of concern: Deadline extension for IL documents*

Morning show hosts, Mateusz Pankiewicz and Magda Marczevska, reminded the listeners that the Illinois Secretary of State's office announced that the deadline to renew driver's licenses, ID cards and license plate stickers was extended to Nov. 1. This new extension also applied to those who have July, August and September expiration dates.

2. *Afternoon with 103.1 FM* (August 5, 4:00 p.m., segment duration 6:54 min.)

*Issue of concern: Free legal help*

A free legal clinic open to people of all languages and backgrounds sounds too good to be true, but it's exactly what Amicus Poloniae offers its clients! Though they focus on Polish and English-speaking clients, the goal of Amicus Poloniae is to help guide others
