WNXP

WNXP is a music discovery station serving Nashville and Middle Tennessee striving to reflect the depth and diversity of the region and its music community through on-air programming and arts journalism presented across multiple platforms. Daily playlists feature artists from emerging to established with a special emphasis across all genres on Nashville.

Our local hosts bring context to the music and connect to the community through live updates on air and in-person events. With hosts that include award-winning journalists, these updates go deeper than biographical information and serve to enrich the listener's experience.

Fourth Quarter of 2022

In the fall of 2022, WNXF featured more voices on the air and online, beyond its established series (Record of the Week, What Where Whensday, Nashville Artist of the Month, Singled Out etc.), and began to create more event opportunities in the community.

As pandemic restrictions lifted even more, the station welcomed an unprecedented number of artists and community members in for interviews to bring context and insight on topics from the future of independent venues in Nashville to the poetic impact of mold on the music of a rising songwriter.

WNXP's flagship one hour show, the New Music Experience also brought in more interviews, analysis and commentary to help create a "front door" to the station, showcasing its finest work from editorial features to live sessions.

A diverse, inclusive, and eclectic group of artists (Ethel Cain, Tim Gent, Fontaines DC etc.) came through the Sonic Cathedral performance space for live sessions shared through NPR Music, YouTube, social media and on-air. Many of the sessions were selected by NPR Music or their Song of the Day feature often bringing independent Nashville artists to a much wider audience. The first offsite live session also took place at Third Man Records' Blue Room space and provided an opportunity to better engage with station members and the live music community.

WNXP created events (beyond our "Presenting" partnerships with venues and artists) were added throughout the fall including a Trivia night and a sold out Second Anniversary party featuring Grammy nominated indie breakout stars Wet Leg and two rising Nashville artists Twen and Veaux.

WNXP's weekly look at music, arts, and community events in Middle Tennessee - What Where Wednesdays – continued to spotlight a wide variety of happenings while simultaneously providing a broader cultural context through conversations with artists and community members.

Station DJ's also celebrated the lives of many important figures who died this year, including Loretta Lynn, with special theme sets and analysis.
