Savannah's beautiful River Street with its walkways and plazas was anything but beautiful in the 1970's. What once was a mud street with open sewers and rotten wharves is now the place to see - and be seen - for Savannahians and visitors from around the world. The 1973 master plan, by architects Bob Gunn and Eric Meyerhoff, cost a whopping (for the time) \$7.3 million and was done with the encouragement from then-Mayor Rousakis for whom the main plaza is named. Recently architect Eric Meyerhoff donated hundreds of photographs taken during the renovation to the City of Savannah Library and Archives. We'll speak with Mr. Meyerhoff about his vision for this and other projects in Savannah.
