To assist you in complying with the reporting requirements for children's television and the requirement that stations air "core" children's programming, we are providing you with episode-specific descriptions (the 'NBC Kids' educational and informational programming block) as set forth in the attached Community Relations Quarterly Children's Programming Report for 4th quarter 2012. The report includes information to help prepare FCC Form 398. Please note that we have not included the specific dates and times for each of the programs as that may be station-specific.

This report is divided into the following categories:

1. Educational Objectives: NBC Kids for both 4th quarter 2012 and 1st quarter 2013.
2. Core programming: Regularly scheduled programming furnished by the NBC Network that is specifically designed to serve the early educational and informational needs of children 16 and under. Each of these programs is identified on-air as educational and informational with the "E/I" icon, and is similarly identified to the national listing services. To assist stations with the preemption report section of FCC Form 398, we have added specific episode numbers. Please note that the age target for NBC Kids programming is identified as 2-5 years old.
3. Other programming: Programming furnished by the NBC Network that contributes to the educational and informational needs of children 16 and under, but is not specifically designed to meet the educational and informational needs of children.
4. Public service announcements targeted to children 16 and under.
5. Non-broadcast efforts that enhance the educational and informational value of NBC Network programming to children.
6. Network on-air promotional efforts, which include a schedule of NBC on-air promos for NBC Kids programming.

The regularly-scheduled children's programming and promotional content furnished to you by the NBC Network during the 4th quarter of 2012 complied with the commercial limits of the Children's Television Act, and 47 C.F.R. §§ 73.670(a)-(d), provided that you broadcast and distributed such programming as furnished to you by NBC, and did not add any promotional or advertising content there to other than as directed by NBC via weekly postings on APT.

#### 4TH QUARTER 2012 EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

In compliance with the Children's Television regulations that became effective January 2, 1997, the **SPROUT Programming Block on NBC** features an on-air icon (E/I) indicating that each program is "educational and informational" for children. **This icon is displayed throughout each program.** Also, in compliance with the regulations, the following document, which includes "early educational and informational" objectives of **SPROUT on NBC**, must be placed in your public file.

Each of the programs listed below, which make up the **SPROUT on NBC** programming block, is specifically designed to serve the *early educational and informational* needs of children ages 2-5. Each of the shows listed was developed by the award winning **Sprout** network, now on **NBC**. All of the programs have educational objectives and messages that are central to the content and appropriate for the program genre.

From October 6, 2012 – December 29, 2012, **SPROUT on NBC** aired six shows. These are: **Justin Time, Lazy Town, The Pajanimals, Poppy Cat, Noodle and Doodle, and The Wiggles.**

All six shows were developed specifically for a target audience composed of children from 2-5 years of age and are diverse in the range of content and formats. Five of the shows engage elements of fantasy and imagination to express the educational content. Four of the shows (**The Pajanimals, Poppy Cat, Lazy Town, and Justin Time**) have a narrative format. One of the shows, **The Wiggles**, is a lesson based musical variety show, and the last, **Noodle and Doodle**, provides specific lessons on recycling materials to create art projects.

**Justin Time** features a little boy, Justin, who wants very much to master his destiny, have great adventures, and solve problems. He begins with a problem that vexes him and daydreams his way into an adventure that takes him to different places around the world, providing him with an experience to help solve his problem when he returns home. Justin is accompanied by two imaginary friends throughout his adventures; Olive, a knowledgeable playmate, and Squidgy, the morphing flying sponge, who provides commentary and comedy along the way. Some examples of Justin's lessons involve learning that it takes focus to achieve success, our failures can teach what we need to do to succeed next time, or when one path to solve a problem doesn't work, you can find an alternative way to achieve your goal. Justin promotes self-directed learning from the young child's perspective and imagination.

**Lazy Town** encourages fitness and healthful habits for preschool children. In the imaginary setting of Lazy Town, characters' eating and fitness habits are linked to problem solving in their world. The lead character is Stephanie, a young girl who guides the audience through the story as she and her friends ("human" puppets) and her Uncle (Mayor Milford Meanswell) navigate life within Lazy Town. Robbie Rotten, the underground spy and influencer who personifies the ethos of Lazy Town, is determined to ruin the health and fitness practices of Stephanie and her friends. When the kids have difficulty with Robbie Rotten, Sportacus, a gymnast/athlete prepared to answer any call for help, comes to the rescue from his home in a zeppelin-like aircraft that hovers over earth. The underlying themes of Lazy Town stress the importance of eating "sports candy" (aka fruits and vegetables), always obtaining sufficient sleep, and going outside to engage in a wide range of physical activities including playing games, competing athletically, and even building forts and play structures.

**The Pajanimals** are a group of four preschool aged puppets who live together in a house with their off-screen mother and father. They reside primarily in their bedroom, a dormitory of sorts, where they complete their nighttime routine of brushing teeth and conversing quietly before falling to sleep. The quiet time, always turns into a discussion that results in a dream-like adventure to solve a problem, such as



overcoming shyness, making a new friend, or dealing with a bully. The adventure takes place in several nighttime dream locales where special friends help them work through the social/emotional problem of the day. Specific approaches to managing the problem are demonstrated and practiced throughout the adventure. The children return home in time to get ample rest, confident about facing their issues when they awaken the following day.

**Poppy Cat**, based on the book series by Lara Jones, models the use of imagination and storytelling to encourage creative thinking in viewers. Each episode features the narrator Lara, reading a story about Poppy Cat, to her own cat (who is also named Poppy). She weaves an exciting tale following her imagination, which leads her to distant lands reached by boat, plane, hot air balloon or train. Each story features Poppy Cat, as the leader of a group of animal friends, a resident bully Egbert the badger, and other occasionally recurring characters. A prevailing message emerges within each episode to be nice to your friends and always work together. There remains an overarching implicit message within every episode as well: think creatively and exercise your mind through reading and storytelling – for these activities always lead to enjoyment and adventure.

**Noodle and Doodle**, an instructional series, features creating art projects and cooking projects around a specific theme. Host, Sean, drives around in a double-decker bus fully equipped with art supplies and a kitchen, ready for any assignment. The projects encourage parent engagement and often feature families working together to make something to display within the child's home. Sean's side-kick, Doggity, is an ever-faithful beagle who transforms into an animated character during interstitial trips to a parallel universe, set in a kitchen full of prank playing animated characters. The art projects typically promote utilizing recycled materials in order to demonstrate that creativity can transform something intended for one purpose into something that achieves a completely different goal.

**The Wiggles** is a musical variety show specifically designed for pre-school children. Starring Tony, Murray, Greg and Jeff, the Wiggles offer a montage of skits that are specifically designed for teaching and entertaining the preschool audience. Supported by an ensemble of characters, larger than life animals (humans dressed as animal characters) as well as a pirate, Captain Feathersword; the Wiggles teach numbers, letters, colors, matching and classifying what belongs together (or not), and following directions. Featuring dancing and occasional guest artists the Wiggles provides a plethora of visual interest for the viewer, while presenting the lessons in an easily understandable and developmentally appropriate manner for the preschool child.

### **1ST QUARTER 2013 EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES**

There is one new show for the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2013. This show will premiere on February 9, 2013.

**Chica** is a five-year-old "baby" chick who spends her days with her parents in their costume shop, the Coop. The shop's one employee, Kelly, doubles as Chica's nanny and the ensemble is rounded out with Bunji, a large floppy eared rabbit and Stitches, a straw mannequin that sits in the window. In each episode Chica develops or encounters a problem that she cannot immediately resolve. Usually her issues involve impulse control, distractibility, judgment, and inter-personal behaviors. She and Kelly usually work on the problem through an adventure—a fantasy transformation to animation—where Bunji and Stitches come alive and join Chica and Kelly for the problem solving process. The core educational content is primarily socio-emotional development, and Chica learns how to express herself properly, think before she acts, and interact with others effectively. She often learns that it takes hard work and practice to become proficient at different skills.

They decide to make "baby" angel food cakes and "big-sister" badges from recycled plastic jar lids to make the homecoming special. Sean and Noodle make baby angel food cakes. They share the tasks and clean up together. In Doggity's animation imagination segment the gang makes swaddled sandwich wraps for moms of newborns that are busy holding their babies. The kids work with Sean to create the big sister badges and take the baby angel food cakes to share with their family when baby Nate arrives home.

**[Educational Message: We can celebrate special moments in our lives, like a new baby brother arriving home, by making big sister badges and sharing a special treat together.]**

#### **MOM IS AMAZING [EPAJ125H]**

#### **MISSING KEYS [EPCT102H]**

The group decides to go on a fishing trip. When Zuzu gets scared he startles Mo causing him to lose all of his prized keys in the lake. They take an adventure in the submarine in search of Mo's missing keys but when Egbert arrives to stop them from proceeding, he accidentally puts a hole in the submarine causing it to sink. The group decides to continue on foot underwater and they run into a giant squid that has Mo's keys. Although they are scared, they politely ask the squid for the keys and they are returned. Alma gives Mo the treasure ring that she found for him to put his key on so he never loses them again.

**[Educational Message: By working together, the friends solved a problem and conquered their fears.]**

#### **GOING COCONUTS [EPCT102H]**

After Mo beats Zuzu in a race, he accidentally sets off a ricochet that destroys Owl's nest. Poppy and her friends take an adventure to Coconut Island to make Owl a new bed out of coconut leaves. During a call to air traffic control for landing, Egbert intercepts and tells them they cannot land on the island. After finally convincing Egbert to let them pass, they break the wheel on the plane. Egbert takes them to find a replacement wheel but gets everyone lost. On the way, they find the coconut tree and work together to gather the leaves for Owl's new bed. They are able to fix the plane and make it home safely so Owl can enjoy his new bed.



**[Educational Message: When things seem unfixable look around you to find new solutions to your problems.]**

Luckily, they find the culprit, a monkey, who must give back the mask, but then is able to share in the party fun. **THE VERY LARGE BOOK OF PETS [EJTM101H]**

Justin wants a pet, but his Dad warns him that he isn't ready for that responsibility. He enters his imaginary world where he, Squidgy, and Olive obtain and attempt to care for a pet elephant. It proves to be exhausting, and Justin returns home realizing that you can't "turn off" a real pet, so he will happily go to the zoo.

**[Educational Message: Sometimes things that seem fun, are actually more responsibility than we are ready to handle, so thinking of alternatives to our original desire might be better than getting what we want.]**

**LAZY TOWN**

**CRY DINOSAUR [ELZT107H]**

Stephanie, Ziggy and Stingy are going camping, but Ziggy is afraid of the dark. He asks Sportacus if he is afraid of anything, listing many possibilities, and Sportacus admits he would be afraid of a large dinosaur. Robbie Rotten is thrilled to hear Sportacus' weakness and disguises himself as a dinosaur to scare Sportacus out of Lazytown forever! When the kids settle down into their tent, Stephanie and Stingy calm Ziggy's fears with a song, but they immediately are terrified by the shadow of Uncle Milford on the tent. They decide to hold a camp-in at Stephanie's house. Ziggy hears a commotion and sees the Robbie Rotten dinosaur and becomes scared. Stephanie and Stingy go out to explore and leave the door open for Robbie Rotten to get inside the house and scare Ziggy some more before all the kids see him and run and hide. When the dinosaur goes after Stephanie and Stingy, Ziggy realizes he had to save them; he finds courage and tackles Robbie Rotten, causing the costume to fly onto Stingy. Sportacus comes to save them and congratulates Ziggy on being brave to save his friends.

**[Educational Message: When you are afraid, and you still take action to protect your friends, you are demonstrating true courage.]**

**THE WIGGLES**

**EPISODE 0002 [EWIG102]**

This episode begins with The Twist, where children are invited to follow directions to join in the song and dance. Next is Dorothy's Dancing Alphabet where the G is for Gorilla Dance. We are then invited into the Wiggle House to learn what each Wiggle likes to do during alone time – Greg likes to read, Jeff likes to sleep, Anthony likes to eat, and Murray loves music. In brief animal segments we are introduced to



wombats and chickens. There is a Hebrew language segment learning "walk", "stop", and "run" and inviting the audience to learn the words by joining the actions. The viewers play Charades when each Wiggle acts out a different animal, and then enjoy a song about a trip to the country which also introduces all of the show's characters. Finally, Murray is making his delicious Noodle Surprise and everyone is shocked when Anthony does not feel like eating. They call Dr. Verygood, who shows us how doctors use tongue-depressors, stethoscopes, thermometers, blood pressure gauges, and finally questions to understand why a patient doesn't feel well. As it turns out, Anthony ate too many sweets all day with his friends – but Dr. Verygood rewarded the Wiggles for calling her to investigate when something wasn't right. The show ends with Dorothy's Dancing Alphabet where I is for Italia, and Katarina demonstrates a dance in Italian.

**[Educational Message: We can learn letters, numbers, words, languages, traditions and cultures through song, dance, guessing, role-playing, and repetition. Doctors are here to help investigate problems.]**

#### **DINNER WITH GRANDMA [ENAD115]**

Sean and Noodle prepare the porcupine meatballs using teamwork and kitchen safety. In Doggity's animation imagination segment the gang makes dessert for the grandparents. They remind DeedleDee to be polite and respectful to everyone, but especially to grandparents. They make a granny smith apple pie and DeedleDee practices being especially sweet and kind to the grandparents. The kids make the placemats using photographs of their family and colored rice, feathers, and small decorative craft items.

**[Educational Message: You can make a special meal and serve it on top of special family photograph placemats to create a memorable family dinner time together.]**

#### **IT'S A BAND! [ENAD115]**

Ray and his friends love music and marching bands, and want Sean to help them make some instruments to make a band. They brainstorm together to make shaker drums and "chicken, lickin' drumsticks". The kids collect recycled items for the drums while Sean and Noodle make the drumsticks. In Doggity's animation imagination segment the gang makes a spinning spinach salad tutu to energize the ballerinas. The kids make the shaker drums from recycled items and take the chicken drumsticks to enjoy together after marching and making some music.

**[Educational Message: If you and your friends like music you can design shaker drums from recycled items to make a marching band that plays together.]**

### **PAJANIMALS**

#### **SING A PAJANIMAL SONG [EPAJ115H]**

The Pajanimals have formed a band and are ready to debut their new song. Apollo hasn't practiced and keeps forgetting his words, forcing them to stop and try again. Apollo becomes frustrated and decides to quit the band. His departure causes everyone concern and they visit Edwin in Storybook Land for help. They learn the importance of practice and determination when trying to learn something new. Apollo tries his song again without giving up, and finishes with the Pajanimal band.

**[Educational Message: When you make a mistake, instead of quitting, continue to practice until you get it right.]**



### **TIME OUT FOR TWO [EPAJ115H]**

Squacky and Cowbella get into a fight over a toy. Mom puts them on a time out to calm down and work out their feelings, and reminds them to never hit anyone. They apologize and make up, but at bedtime they begin to worry that Mom may be mad at them for fighting. They visit Bedtime Bunny for advice and she explains that their Mother gave them a timeout to help them calm down and teach them a lesson because she loves them, not because she is mad at them.

**[Educational Message: When you do something wrong and your parents put you on a time out, remember they are just trying to remind you to calm down and use your words instead.]**

Just as they are finishing, Egbert (aka Baron von Speedster) arrives and insists that they follow him on a shortcut to Pickle Springs. Although Egbert gets them lost, they are still able to find Pickle Springs, where Mo quickly drinks to cure his hiccups. Before heading back to the garden, they decide to continue their delicious picnic in the car.

**[Educational Message: By working together as a team everyone was able to help a friend in need.]**

### **FLOWER POWER [EPCT104H]**

Mo gets Alma perfume as a gift for helping him get over his fear of dandelion fluff, but Zuzu's bouncy ball accidentally breaks her new gift. Poppy Cat suggests going to the Elephant Jungle to make new perfume out of lily dew drops to replace it. In the Jungle, Egbert appears dressed as a Naughty Monkey and demands the group hand over all their supplies, including the airplane. Stranded, they meet Toby the Elephant in the jungle who takes them to the giant lily to make new perfume for Alma. Toby's size intimidates Egbert and the group can head home to the garden with their plane, supplies, and Alma's new perfume.

**[Educational Message: Sometimes when you are being bullied, having an imposing friend who can stand up to the bully will convince the bully to go away.]**

Upon returning home, Justin and his Dad camp out in the living room and discover fun even when their plans are foiled.

**[Educational Message: Being creative will allow you to make the most of changed plans.]**

### **FOLLOW THOSE CHICKENS! [EJTM103H]**

Justin's ball is missing and he tries to use clues to find it. He enters Australia in his imagination, and has to use clues to help Squidgy and Olive find the missing chickens. He first accuses the baby animals, but then realizes he was wrong. Upon returning home, he realized Dad had taken the ball to blow it up, and Justin apologizes for mistakenly blaming the neighbor's dog.

**[Educational Message: If you ever mistakenly accuse someone of something, you should apologize for it.]**

## **LAZY TOWN**

### **ROTTENBEARD [ELZT106H]**

He took everything he wanted, except the Lazy Town stone which was inscribed with the secret to living in Lazy Town. Rottenbeard broke the stone when he couldn't steal it outright and now it is missing the key-word that reveals the most important secret of Lazy Town. Robbie Rotten, who doesn't like the kids playing and being noisily active decides to make a fake Lazy Town stone and lead the kids on a wild goose chase to find a fake stone that would tell them to "be lazy." But Stephanie is not convinced they should be lazy and leans on the real stone, only to uncover a compartment with a new treasure map. Once they retrieve the real stone, with substantial help from Sportacus, they find out that the secret to living in Lazy Town is to be HAPPY.

**[Educational Message: Being lazy is very boring, but being active, like playing and dancing with your friends, will make you very happy.]**

## **THE WIGGLES**

### **EPISODE 0004 [EWIG104]**

Next Dorothy tries to help Wags determine if he's sick, she encourages some exercise to help him "feel better" and "warm up." Following the Letter Song and Theme Song, Henry the Octopus takes the audience on a journey to Gowa, a tiny island north of Australia. While there, he teaches some of the Waramiri vocabulary for octopus and fishing, learns how the people have been fishing there for hundreds of years, and visits a school where all the kids do the Henry Dance as they sing. Then a short Mail Carrier segment follows, where the audience guesses who the mail is from. Finally there is a guitar performance where a friend comes along to help finish the song.

**[Educational Message: We can learn new words, letters, numbers, languages, traditions and cultures through repetition, guessing, song, role-playing and rhyming.]**

### **A FRIEND AT THE HOSPITAL [ENAD116]**

Megan and Gio's neighbor Owen is in the hospital after an operation. They want to make something to cheer him up. They brainstorm together to make cupcake paper flowers and fresh fruit flowers. Sean and Noodle make the fresh fruit flowers using cookie cutters while the kids collect items to make the cupcake paper flowers. In Doggity's animation imagination segment the gang makes some "grub" for cowboys – laso lasagna. The kids make the cupcake paper flowers using branches from their yard and take the craft and the fruit treat to share with Owen and cheer him up.

**[Educational Message: A friend can cheer someone up and make them feel better by making a gift that is a reminder of home, and also making special healthy treats to show how much they care.]**

### **BIRDS IN MY BACKYARD [ENAD116]**

Isabella and her neighbors Olivia and Jaylan want to feed the birds in their neighborhood. They brainstorm together to make oat and seed feeders using recycled containers and decide to design a house to keep the food dry in case it rains. Sean and Noodle make the seed feeders. In Doggity's animation imagination



segment the gang makes frozen banana pops for hungry monkeys. The kids make the birdhouses using recycled containers and twigs. They hang the feeders in their backyards for the birds in their neighborhood to enjoy!

**[Educational Message: You can make bird feeders to hang up in your yard using recycled items and bird seed feeders you create in the kitchen.]**

The Pajanimals take an adventure to the Land of Play to see Coach Whistler. He reminds them that excluding your loved ones is hurtful and everyone should be included. **[Educational Message: Always include friends in every game because it's not nice to tell someone they cannot play.]**

#### **TEAM FORT [EPAJ116H]**

Apollo and Squacky ask the girls for their blankets to build a fort, but when they see how great it is they decide to take their things back and build their own. Their fight gets so big that they stop sharing everything and give each other the silent treatment. The Pajanimals decide to visit the Land of Build It to help fix their problem. Frank and Hank teach them that working as a team helps you work better and faster and work together.

**[Educational Message: When you play together you have to share, listen and work as a team.]**

The power goes out right as Poppy and her friends see Rocket Cat in trouble on the television. They decide to take the rocket ship to his location to help him out. When they arrive, Egbert is already there and captures them to work in his Marshmallow Mines. When Marshmallow crème begins to pour from the walls, Egbert leaves them trapped and escapes using Rocket Cat's magnet boots. Mo suggests that they step in the sticky crème and escape the mine. They discover Rocket Cat trapped under some rocks and they rescue him. Poppy Cat and her friends drop Rocket Cat off at his house and head back to the garden as heroes.

**[Educational Message: By using their imagination, the friends are able to find solutions to their problems.]**

Justin is relaxing after his birthday party. When he and Squidgy meet Olive in the imaginary world Justin becomes a sultan with many wishes. He wishes his birthday could be every day – but it proves to be too much and the birthday traditions lose their meaning. When he returns home he thanks his mom for making the birthday so special.

**[Educational Message: Value special moments and appreciate the rarity, as it is part of what makes these moments special.]**

Pixel and Stephanie apologize for being lazy and mean to each other, they agree that there are not any shortcuts for the work that needs to be done.

Noodle and Sean make pineapple sunset smoothies. In Doggity's animation imagination segment the gang makes frozen banana pops for monkeys. The kids are able to take the smoothies and enjoy some bubble-blowing paint time together.

**[Educational Message: You can find new ways to enjoy your favorite activity, like super bubble blowers you can use to paint pictures with bubbles.]**

Sean and Noodle work together to make the golden fish nugget treasures while the kids get ready for the pirate party. In Doggity's animation imagination segment the gang prepares treasure chest treats using dried fruits for a group of pirates. The kids come back and create the pirate telescopes. They take the crafts and treats to the party to enjoy together!

**[Educational Message: You can make all the decorations and treats for a party from things around your house.]**

## **NOODLE AND DOODLE**

### **OUR FAMILY APPLE TREE [ENAD121]**

Scott and Elena have a lot of apples and need to find a way to use them! They brainstorm to make a family apple tree using apple stamps, family photos, and the kids handprints; they will use apples to make apple blueberry crumbles. Sean and Noodle make the apple blueberry crumbles in the kitchen while the kids gather the items for the craft project. In Doggity's animation imagination segment the game makes crispy baked veggies to use the vegetables from the harvest. The kids return and enjoy using the apples to create an apple family tree. They share the family tree and delicious apple blueberry crumbles with their family.

**[Educational Message: You can celebrate harvest by making a creative apple family tree and enjoying healthy harvest treats.]**

### **BAKE SALE [ENAD121]**

Aiden and Julia are helping with a bake sale to raise money for their school. They brainstorm to make butterfly cupcakes and a piggy bank for keeping the money. Sean and Noodle work in the kitchen to make the butterfly cupcakes. They save the milk and egg containers and repurpose them to make a piggy bank. In Doggity's animation imagination segment the gang makes apple-icious grilled cheese sandwiches for a hungry group of teachers. The kids return and create the piggy bank to keep their earnings.

**[Educational Message: You can help with a bake-sale fundraiser by making crafty treats and make a piggy bank from recycled items for a fun way to keep the money safe during the sale.]**

## **PAJANIMALS**

### **I CAN DO IT BETTER [EPAJ121H]**

Sweetpea Sue and Apollo are competing to see which of them does everything better than the other. At bedtime, they are still arguing so much about which one is better that Squacky and Cowbella suggest they get some help. They take an adventure to the Land of Build It to finally find out who is best. However, they



realize that no one is the best at everything and they shouldn't compete against one another, but be encouraging instead.

**[Educational Message: No one is better than anyone else at everything because we all have special talents.]**

#### **OOPS [EPAJ121H]**

Squacky is ready to try sleeping without a diaper since he has been using the potty so well. Right before bed, he drinks too much water and wets his bed during the night. Sweetpea Sue knows what to do and helps him to change his sheets and pajamas. He is still disappointed about his accident and asks for help from the Moon. Moon offers advice on listening to your body at bedtime so that you don't have accidents. Squacky is ready for bed and feels better knowing that his body is still learning and tomorrow is a brand new day.

**[Educational Message: Having an accident may happen when you are learning to stay dry at night.]**

On the trip, Zuzu is still upset and takes his frustration out on Mo, making him feel bad about his bubbles. When their boat gets stuck, Mo uses his bubble blowing skills to make a bubble large enough for everyone to travel to the island. Zuzu apologizes for being mean to Mo and everyone spends the entire day with Poppy's friend Ravi blowing bubbles.

**[Educational Message: We all have different talents, if you can't do something you shouldn't be mean to your friend because they can.]**

#### **DRIPPY FOREST [EPCT116H]**

While jumping in the fall leaves, Owl finds a Drippy Forest wiggly bug and names him Thurston. The group decides to return Thurston to his home in the forest so he can be comfortable and with his friends. Owl is afraid of insects, but he joins everyone as they return Thurston to his home. On the way their van has engine trouble and although Owl is scared, he conquers his fear and flies Thurston home to his tree in the forest.

**[Educational Message: Courage and bravery are about forgetting your fears and doing what's best for others despite your fears.]**

#### **WAIT, LITTLE PENGUIN! [EJTM102H]**

Justin and Mom are going to go skating and Mom has to look for her skates. He enters his imagination where he, Olive, and Squidgy try to help a little penguin that is separated from its family. They think the penguin is playful or confused, instead of realizing that the penguin was really leading the way back to its



family the entire time, and the kids were just not listening. When returning home, Justin realizes he should listen to his Mom while skating, because "if I would have listened the first time . . . I wouldn't have fallen."

**[Educational Message: Listening is more than just hearing words, it's realizing the meaning behind the communication.]**

**[Educational Message: Singing, dancing, and sharing music together is very special and can teach us many interesting lessons.]**

**THE WIGGLES**

**EPISODE 0003 [EWIG103]**

In this episode the Wiggles begin with teaching the five senses through an Eyes, Ears, Nose, Hands, Tongue to Taste song involving movement and repetition that allows audience participation. The Duke of York Song is a classic story rhyme, repetitive enough for children to attempt to join in on. Next, a "What Happens is Up to You Story" is told, where from the beginning viewers are invited to join in, follow directions, and engage – in this case through a firefighter's story utilizing firefighter vocabulary. After two songs, there is a Jack and Jill song/story classic that is repetitive enough for children to join in and sing. Next is a Guessing Game where Anthony is a Bumble-Bee, focusing on bumble bee vocabulary. Then Ring Around a Rosie provides clear instructions along with an invitation for participation. After a short Postwoman segment there is a Lassie/Laddie song to conclude the show.

**[Educational Message: We can learn about senses, new words, classic rhymes and songs all through repetition, guessing, singing, role-playing and rhyming.]**

Kevin and Katie are going on a road trip and want to think of some games to play. They brainstorm together to make a bingo road game using a recycled egg carton. In Doggity's imagination animation segment the gang makes lasagna to feed a group of hungry cowboys. The kids return and make the bingo game using the recycled egg cartons and photographs. They take both the game and the pin-wheel snack on their road trip.

**[Educational Message: You can make a creative game for a family road trip from recycled items; and create a snack for the journey].**

**IT'S A HOT, HOT, DAY! [ENAD122]**

It is a really hot day, and a group of friends are doing all they can to stay cool. They brainstorm with Sean to make watermelon ice pops and colored ice cube pictures. In Doggity's imagination animation segment they make treasure chest treats using dried fruit for a group of hungry pirates. The kids return and freeze



colored water pops to use to paint paper towel ice cream cones. They enjoy all the creative ways to stay cool on a hot day together.

**[Educational Message: You can find creative ways to stay cool on a hot day, like making frozen colored art work and watermelon ice pops.]**

#### **PAJANIMALS**

##### **ONE TEACUP, TWO FRIENDS [EPAJ122R1H]**

At bedtime, Sweetpea Sue is still upset, so they take an adventure to the Moon where they sing about feelings and sharing. ##### **THE WONDERFULLY DIFFERENT SQUACKY [EPAJ122R1H]**

The Pajanimals are calling out all of the things that make Squacky different leading him to question whether being different is a good thing. At bedtime, Squacky asks for some help so they take a visit to see Granny Pearl. She explains that she is different too and that's what makes her special. The Pajanimals realize that they are all different in cool ways and that's what makes them unique.

**[Educational Message: We are all wonderful just the way we are because it is our differences that make us special.]**

When they start to lose speed, Gilda stops by and suggests they remove some supplies from the balloon to lighten the load. They work together to help Poppy navigate just as Egbert attempts to beat them to the finish line. All their hard work pays off and they accomplish the goal by setting the world record.

**[Educational Message: Great teamwork is the best solution to accomplishing a big goal.]**

He gets a big, fast wagon, which ultimately gets stuck as he had been forewarned. When he returns home, he realizes that his little wagon is reliable and big enough for what he needs.

**[Educational Message: We don't always need newer and bigger things in our lives, bigger is not always better.]**

Robbie Rotten hears them say they won't be able to play with so much trash, and he concocts a new plan to cover the town in trash so the kids can no longer play. Stingy sets up his recycling center, and Robbie Rotten steals all the trash and bombards the city with it. The kids worry that they'll never be able to play again, but when they realize Ziggy is stuck in the trash Stingy rushes out to get Sportacus to save his friend. They clean up Lazytown working together.

**[Educational Message: It is selfish to unload your trash to someone else; working together we can keep our home and community clean and help the environment by recycling.]**

#### **THE WIGGLES**

#### **EPISODE 0005 [EWIG105]**

This episode starts with One Finger, One Thumb, Keep Moving Song, followed by a scene where each character in the show is introduced and shares about a unique interest they have. After a Three Little Kittens Lost Their Mittens nursery rhyme with the Wiggles play a guessing game where the audience learns how to distinguish Captain Feathersword from two other men. Besides dressing differently, the gentlemen know how to greet people properly. The next segment is the Duke of York Song, and then the viewers count up to the number nine with rhymes using body parts. The Wiggles practice sounds with an I-Spy word game, and then viewers help tell the story in What Happens Next is Up to You, about tennis. They enjoy Sporting Salsa and conclude with Mary Had a Little Lamb.

**[Educational Message: We can learn letters, numbers, words, languages, traditions and cultures through song, dance, guessing, role-playing, and repetition.]**

segment the gang creates party pita pizzas. The siblings return and make a planet decoration that utilizes painting with a baseball and pizza box in a creative way. They take the decorations and the pizza to enjoy at Tristan's birthday party.

**[Educational Message: You can make special decorations for a birthday party and a special treat all around a common theme – like outer space – using creativity and a little recycling.]**

#### **A TRIP TO THE LAKE [ENAD123]**

Kayden, Micah and Ian are spending the day at the lake and want to make some boats to race. They brainstorm using recycled milk cartons to make boats with sails and frittata boats to eat at a picnic at the lake. Sean and Noodle make the frittata boats while the kids set up for the picnic. In Doggity's Diner animation imagination segment the crew makes sea burgers for scuba diver diners. The kids return and make the sail boats and take the boats and frittatas to enjoy on their day at the lake.

**[Educational Message: You can make a trip to the lake special and memorable by creating crafty sailboats and a picnic.]**

##### **WE'RE GOING CAMPING [EPAJ123R1H]**

The Pajanimals are excited about their pending camping trip. When Apollo mentions that they will have to sleep outside they begin to worry about the trip. At bedtime, the Pajanimals are troubled about sleeping outside in the dark so they travel to the Friendly Forest to ease their thoughts. Jerry tells them that he and Otis sleep outside every night and absolutely love it! Their visit makes them feel much better about the trip and they return to bed, ready to take on their new adventure.

**[Educational Message: If you are brave and do new things you can have fun adventures.]**

Zuzu gives Owl a Welcome Walrus to hang in front of his house but he does not like it. Instead of telling his true feelings, he gives Zuzu excuses of other places to put it. When the walrus goes missing they find clues



that lead them to the Mother Bumblebird and the walrus. On the way home they meet Roger the polar bear who is having problems making friends so they give him the walrus. Owl decides he wants another Walrus and asks Zuzu to make him another.

**[Educational Message: When you receive a gift that you do not like, take time to appreciate the person who gave it to you and you might find you like the gift more than you originally thought.]**

In his imaginary world, he, Olive, and Squidgy are on the Galapagos Islands enjoying the animal life. Justine realizes he wouldn't want to leave if it was his home. He makes a picture zoo instead – and returns home to do the same.

**[Educational Message: Being thoughtful may lead you to realize that your actions are hurtful, be creative to find a positive solution.]**

He destroys each of the segments by trying to tell everyone to be lazy, do nothing, eat junk food, and sleep in. Robbie Rotten is so determined to shut down the station he tries to climb the tower and destroy the signal, but Sportacus saves him and the kids realize that it is Robbie. They are frustrated because their shows have been messed up, but they meet at the theater and perform the Bing Bang (Dance Together) song.

**[Educational Message: Working together with your friends to promote healthy and active living is fun; there may be challenges, but you can overcome them by working together.]**

### **THE WIGGLES**

#### **EPISODE 0007 [EWIG107]**

This episode begins with role-playing and guessing as Anthony is dressed as a butterfly and Captain Feathersword leads the viewers in a guessing game to teach vocabulary. Then Henry the Octopus teaches us a little about birds before Wag the Dog and Dorothy the Dinosaur pretend to be birds together and Dorothy gives instructions. The Farmer in the Dell classic nursery rhyme is acted out, as well as another role-playing activity for the viewers to guess that Anthony is a King. The Wiggles play an organ music guessing game where they distinguish sounds of organs, learn organ vocabulary, and discover a



disguised Captain Feathersword. Finally, Murray plays guitar as they paint a picture with music describing a circus – reinforcing vocabulary and giving ample time for repetition and participation.

**[Educational Message: We can learn letters, numbers, words, languages, traditions and cultures through song, dance, guessing, role-playing and repetition.]**

In Doggity's Diner animation imagination segment the gang makes frosty fruit refreshers for thirsty firefighters. Drew and his dad return and design and construct a digger costume. They go to the park and share the costume and tower of fries with friends.

**[Educational Message: You can make a costume about something that you love using recycled items from your house.]**

#### **WOOF! WOOF! [ENAD117]**

Chloe and Malachi are trying to get their new dog Tulah to sit. They brainstorm making dog training treats and make a cute doghouse in which to keep the treats. Sean and Noodle make the dog bone treats together in the kitchen. In Doggity's Diner animation imagination segment the game makes a royal omelet fit for a king and queen. The kids return after walking their dog and enjoy making the dog house container using craft sticks, an old tissue box, and foil. They take the treats and houses and continue training their dog!

**[Educational Message: You can make dog treats to train a new dog and a crafty container to keep the treats in.]**

**[Educational Message: It is fine to laugh with your friends but never at them.]**

#### **NO MORE BULLIES [EPAJ124R1H]**

When Apollo loses the game of "Cowbella Says" he feels badly and decides to quit. He tells them that the bigger kids at school said he is bad at playing games and has big ears. The Pajanimals try to cheer him up, but Apollo decides he's not going back to school because the other kids are mean. They visit the Friendly Forest for advice, and Jerry gives Apollo a plan to deal with bullies. Apollo feels much better and is ready to go back to school with the plan.

**[Educational Message: If you are being picked on ask them to stop, and if that doesn't work walk away and tell a grown-up.]**

Alma has a dream that Zuzu is a space monster and fears that he has changed. Poppy Cat tries to convince everyone to calm down and remember that Zuzu is the same friend he always has been. When Zuzu arrives in the garden everyone is acting suspicious because of Alma's dream. Zuzu suggests that they all go on a space adventure, furthering Alma's suspicions about Zuzu. Egbert enters the rocket dressed as Cluck-a-roo and takes over the ship sending in straight into an asteroid field. Zuzu jumps in and steers the rocket away from the asteroids saving everyone. Alma tells Zuzu all about her dream and apologizes for having doubted him.

They take the cards and treat to Acer to enjoy his birthday together!

**[Educational Message: You can make a card and treat to show your friend how much you care about him for his birthday; if you have a blind friend, you can be sure the card engages all the senses.]**
