**POLITICAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT  
PRIMARY ELECTION, 2015  
RADIO STATIONS WNAE-FM, WRRN-FM, WKNB-FM  
WARREN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

During their election campaigns, all legally qualified candidates are entitled to purchase time on WNAE-FM, WRRN-FM and WKNB-FM will consider all requests for such time and will make reasonable accommodations to meet such requests. Although each such candidate has the right to "reasonable access" to the facilities of WNAE-FM, WRRN-FM and WKNB-FM for the airing of political advertisements, WNAE-FM, WRRN-FM and WKNB-FM retain the right to limit the amount of time sold to a candidate and has the ultimate discretion with respect to the placement of political advertisements.

During the 45 days preceding a primary election and the 60 days before a general election, WNAE-FM, WRRN-FM and WKNB-FM charge candidates in the respective elections the "lowest unit charge" for an advertisement if the advertisement constitutes a "use" of the WNAE-FM, WRRN-FM and WKNB-FM facilities. The advertisement is considered to be a "use" if it is controlled, sponsored or approved by the candidate or the candidate's campaign committee. During any period other than the 45-day and 60-day periods, the charges for political advertisements constituting a "use" are set so as to be no higher than those charged other advertisers for comparable use of the stations' facilities. Any political advertisement that is not a use, including any advertisement purchased by an independent political action committee or any advertisement dealing with non-candidate ballot issues, is sold at prevailing commercial rates. If a political advertisement constitutes a use, WNAE-FM, WRRN-FM and WKNB-FM will provide opposing candidates with "equal opportunities", as established by federal law, to use WNAE-FM's, WRRN-FM's and WKNB-FM's facilities.

The terms and conditions applicable to political advertising on WNAE-FM, WRRN-FM and WKNB-FM are as follows:

1. Sponsorship Identification. A complete sponsor identification, aired in the candidate's voice, must be included in each advertisement as required by FCC rules and regulations.  
In addition, all federal candidates are required to announce the office they are running for, the fact that they approved the ad and who paid for the ad.
2. Credit. Cash at least 1 business day in advance is required.
3. Political Agreement. A signed Agreement Form for Political Broadcasts must

*Issue Advertising*

While party ads can sometimes get LUR, the ad must be a "use" for it to get those rates, as lowest unit rate only applies to "uses" by a candidate. For a spot to be a "use," the candidate's recognizable voice or picture must appear on the ad. If the ad does not even mention the names of the candidates, much less include their voices, it is not a use and does not get LUR.
