This is one of many 100-year celebration events happening in Texas state parks this year. Entry to the park is free on the day of the official 100-Year Celebration (applies to day passes only). Reserve your free day pass online to guarantee entry to the park. Upon arrival the day of the event, the first 500 participants may sign up to participate. Reserving a day pass online does not guarantee participation in Kid Fish 2023. Wristbands that grant entry into the youth fishing area are passed out at the front office on a first come, first serve basis starting at 8am the day of the event.
