Section 1 - News Information and Feature Content Report

During the First Quarter of 2019, WWMI continued its overall commitment to providing listeners with the latest local, national and world news, local traffic updates, weather and hurricane updates, news and cultural updates and features, and public service information.

Section 2 - Hurricane Preparedness

During the First Quarter of 2019, WWMI maintained it's working relationship with AccuWeather. In the event of a Tropical Storm or Hurricane, along with the resources of our partners, WWMI will provide listeners with storm preparation tips, up-to-the minute updates on the storm track and path, and post-storm clean up information. In the event of a direct strike to our listening area, WWMI will activate continuous coverage of the storm auxiliary means. Additionally, in the event of any major breaking news or weather-related emergencies, WWMI will break into regular programming to deliver information to our listeners as soon as possible. WWMI has 24 hour per day assistance from our news partners and the Salem Radio Network News.

Section 3: Quarterly Issues and Concerns Report

WWMI, on a continuing basis seeks to stay informed regarding the issues, problems, concerns, and needs of its service area. This is accomplished in part through meetings with prominent and informed leaders in the community. WWMI also utilizes informal contacts with community leaders and general media sources outside of our organization (i.e. TV, radio and print media). WWMI management, through membership in civic and charitable organizations maintains active involvement dealing with problems and issues confronting our community. Information is also obtained through general issue-oriented material sent to the station and to station personnel. In this report, WWMI will list the issues it has determined to be of major local concern and will list some of the programming avenues taken to address those issues.

During the First Quarter of 2019, WWMI provided its listeners with programming and public service announcements that addressed issues and concerns of the St. Petersburg community.
