**Date:** 1/17/2004 7pm

**Synopsis:** MOURNERS, INTENDING TO PAY THEIR LAST RESPECTS TO CHRISTOPHER DOSS, BEGAN TO GATHER HERE AT PRINCE OF PEACE CHURCH ON NATURAL BRIDGE IN BERKELEY ABOUT TEN AM.BUT BY 12:30 A DISPUTE GOING ON INSIDE THE CHURCH SPILLED OUT TO THE PARKING LOT.GUNFIRE WAS EXCHANGED DAMAGING SEVERAL CARS.FORTUNATELY NO ONE WAS INJURED.

HIS TEACHER WATCHED THIS YEAR AS THE ONCE QUIET FOURTH GRADER BLOSSOMED. DONNA HORTON says: "He began to talk and let his feeling show and voice his opinions on many things." ANTONIO WAS ON THE COMPUTER HERE AT THE FAMILY HOME ON THOLOZAN LAST NIGHT WHEN POLICE SAY SOMEONE CLIMBED ONTO A BASEMENT WINDOW SILL AND OPENED FIRE. ANTONIO WAS SHOT THE HEAD, DEAD AT THE SCENE. POLICE SAY IT WAS A TARGETED SHOOTING OF THE HOME BUT NOT THE LITTLE BOY. SIX OTHER PEOPLE INCLUDING TWO TEENAGERS LIVED IN THE HOUSE. ONE TEEN HAD BEEN SHOT BEFORE AND WAS BEING QUESTIONED ABOUT THIS SHOOTING.>

**Story:** Newlywed Murder Trial Guilty

**Date:** 3/27/2014 7pm

**Synopsis:** A MONTANA NEWLYWED WHO PLEADED GUILTY TO CHARGES SHE PUSHED HER HUSBAND TO HIS DEATH IN GLACIER NATIONAL PARK HAS BEEN SENTENCED TO 30 YEARS IN PRISON. TWENTY-TWO YEAR-OLD JORDAN GRAHAM WAS FACING LIFE IN PRISON AFTER PLEADING GUILTY TO SECOND-DEGREE MURDER. PROSECUTORS ARGUED SHE WAS HAVING SECOND THOUGHTS ABOUT HER 8-DAY-OLD MARRIAGE TO 25-YEAR-OLD CODY JOHNSON WHEN SHE LURED HIM TO A STEEP CLIFF IN GLACIER NATIONAL PARK ON JULY 7TH AND PUSHED HIM OVER. **Synopsis:** THE STATE OF MISSOURI IS SET TO CARRY OUT ITS \*FIFTH\* EXECUTION...IN FIVE MONTHS. CONVICTED KILLER JEFFREY FERGUSON.. SCHEDULED FOR DEATH JUST AFTER MIDNIGHT TONIGHT AT THE STATE PRISON IN BONNE TERRE. HE WAS CONVICTED IN THE KIDNAPING...RAPE...AND MURDER OF 17-YEAR-OLD KELLI HALL IN 1989. SHE WAS WORKING AT A ST. CHARLES SERVICE STATION...WHEN FERGUSON FORCED HER INTO HIS CAR AT GUNPOINT. HER BODY WAS FOUND ABOUT TWO WEEKS LATER IN A MARYLAND HEIGHTS FARM FIELD.IT'S UNCLEAR \*WHERE\* MISSOURI IS GETTING THE DRUG COMPOUND...NEEDED FOR THE LETHAL INJECTION.

**Date:** 3/19/2014 12pm

**Synopsis:** A SURPRISE GUILTY PLEA... IN THE MURDER OF SEVEN-YEAR-OLD WILLOW LONG. JUSTIN DERYKE... LONG'S UNCLE... PLEADED GUILTY TO HER MURDER. LONG'S BODY WAS FOUND AFTER THOUSANDS OF PEOPLE SEARCHED FOR TWO DAYS AFTER SHE DISAPPEARED IN SEPTEMBER.THE JUDGE SENTENCED DERYKE TO LIFE IN PRISON WITHOUT PAROLE.

**Story:** SXSW Third Victim

**Date:** 3/17/2014 4pm

**Synopsis:** A THIRD VICTIM HAS DIED AFTER BEING STRUCK BY A DRIVER AT THE SOUTH BY SOUTHWEST FESTIVAL LAST WEEK. AUSTIN POLICE IDENTIFIED THE VICTIM AS 26-YEAR-OLD SANDY THUY LE.

POLICE SAY RASHAD OWENS WAS DRUNK WHEN HE DROVE INTO A CROWD OF PEOPLE AT THE FESTIVAL EARLY THURSDAY MORNING. HE WAS CHARGED LAST WEEK WITH TWO COUNTS OF CAPITAL MURDER FOR THE FIRST TWO PEOPLE WHO DIED. POLICE SAY A GRAND JURY WILL DETERMINE IF HE WILL FACE ADDITIONAL CHARGES.

**Story:** Winter Storm Travel

**Date:** 1/2/2014 7pm, 4pm

**Synopsis:** A NOR'EASTER IS MAKING ITS WAY THROUGH THE REGION, BRINGING WITH IT A FOOT OF SNOW, FRIGID TEMPERATURES, AND FIERCE WINDS. THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE HAS ISSUED A WINTER STORM WARNING IN MANY NORTHEASTERN STATES, WITH PARTS OF LONG ISLAND UNDER A BLIZZARD WARNING UNTIL FRIDAY AFTERNOON. OFFICIALS ARE URGING CITIZENS TO BE PREPARED. IN NEW YORK AND NEW HAMPSHIRE, CREWS ARE ALREADY OUT SALTING AND PLOWING THE ROADS. THE STORM HAS ALREADY WREACKED HAVOC ACROSS THE MIDWEST -- BLANKETING ROADS IN OHIO AND INDIANA...AND POUNDING PARTS OF WISCONSIN AND MINNESOTA WHERE TEMPERATURES WERE FORECAST TO REACH 40 BELOW ZERO. FOR TRAVELERS, HEAVY SNOW COULD LEAD TO POOR VISIBILITY ON THE ROADS -- AND IN THE SKY. MORE THAN A THOUSAND FLIGHTS HAVE ALREADY BEEN CANCELLED ACCORDING TO FLIGHT AWARE DOT COM.

**Date:** 1/7/2014 4pm, 7pm

**Synopsis:** IT'S EARLY IN THE MORNING.. MODOT CREW LEADER MIKE CATCHING BEGINS HIS 12 HOUR SHIFT LOADING UP ON HIS MUCH NEEDED SUPPLIES FOR THE DAY.. ROCK SALT AND BEET JUICE. EVEN ARMED WITH SUPPLIES HE KNOWS THE JOB CAN BE TREACHEROUS. CATCHING SAYS HE'S SPREADING AN AVERAGE

OF 20 TONS OF THE CHEMICALS PER DAY... IT'S BEEN TWO DAYS SINCE THE WINTER STORM LEFT BEHIND NEARLY A FOOT OF SNOW... MUCH OF IT STILL AROUND FOR THE MORNING COMMUTE. MIKE HAS BEEN WITH MODOT FOR 4 AND A HALF YEARS... HE CALLS THIS RECENT STORM QUITE A WAR.. THE BIGGEST CHALLENGE HAS BEEN THE SUBZERO TEMPERATURES AS CATCHING'S SHIFT GETS WELL UNDERWAY HE NOTES THAT HE WILL HIT THE SAME AREA 15 TO 20 TIMES. ITS THIS REPITIVE WORK THAT WILL HELP MODOT REACH ITS GOAL TONIGHT OF CLEARING 90 PERCENT OF THE ROADS, THIS CAN ONLY HAPPEN WITH CREWS WORKING AROUND THE CLOCK.

**Story:** City Storm Prep

**Date:** 1/3/2014 7pm

**Synopsis:** 'Even a short time in the deep freeze can cause permanent injury or even death.' THE CITY'S EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER WILL OPEN SATURDAY AFTERNOON AND WILL REMAIN OPEN UNTIL THE WINTER BLAST LETS UP. 'The cold weather will not pose a problem for police services and our ability to respond and will actually step up our response to those areas of need because of the cold weather.' Safety tips just a few- dress in layers both inside and out, wear a hat and gloves, and try to have as little as possible skin exposed. ONE CONCERN IS FOR THE HOMELESS.AN EXTRA WARMING CENTER IS BEING OPENED ON SUNDAY.TEAMS INCLUDING CITY POLICE WILL ALSO CHECK ON THE HOMELESS WHO REFUSE TO COME INSIDE.THERE IS ALSO CONCERN FOR PETS.AUTHORITIES WILL CONFISCATE PETS THAT ARE LEFT IN THE COLD AND CITE OR POSSIBLY PROSECUTE IRRRESPONIBLE PET OWNERS FOR CRUELTY TO ANIMALS.

**Synopsis:** ANOTHER TOUGH DAY FOR DRIVERS IN ILLINOIS ...AS THE STATE TRIES TO BOUNCE BACK FROM A WINTER STORM. ON TOP OF SNOW-COVERED ROADS AND BITTER COLD TEMPERATURES -THEY HAVE TO DEAL WITH SPORADIC GAS SHORTAGES.MAJOR HIGHWAYS WERE CLOSED THIS WEEK BECAUSE OF THE WEATHER MAKING IT TOUGH FOR DELIVERIES. FOR THE NEXT WEEK AND A HALF... ALL ANIMALS WITH SHORT FUR MUST BE BROUGHT INDOORS.AND REMEBER TO STAY WITH KPLR 11 AND FOX 2 NEWS ALL WEEKEND AS WE TRACK THIS WINTER STORM.

**Date:** 1/30/2014, 7pm

**Synopsis:** THAT SNOW STORM EARLIER THIS MONTH IN ST. LOUIS... THAT LEFT BEHIND SEVERAL INCHES OF SNOW IS STILL FRESH ON THE MINDS OF SOME. THE CITY STREETS DEPARTMENT HAD LOTS OF CRITICS BECAME AFTER THE STORM BECAUSE MANY ROADS HAD NOT BEEN CLEARED.ONE ALDERMAN SAID HE WAS SHOCKED OVER THE CONDITIONS DAYS AFTER THE STORM.THE STREETS DIRECTOR EXPLAINS WHAT WENT WRONG.

IT WOULD NOT QUALIFY FOR STATE AID AND MUST FORFEIT ALL SUCH AID DUE IT.
