On November 25, 2011 WRXO-AM and WKRX-FM was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until December 1, 2019.

Our license will expire on December 1, 2019. We must file an application for renewal with the FCC on or before August 1, 2019.
