In addition to the lack of electricity in some areas, food, water and medicines, there are other services that were affected such as garbage collection in housing complexes as well as in various condominiums, foul odors were released, since after the passage of "Otis" the inhabitants also began to take out furniture, mattresses and food in poor condition. Faced with such caos the Diamond and suburban areas decided to burn the waste, so the port woke up with a dense layer of smoke.
