

WTPT-HD2 Quarterly Issues Program List October 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023

Each weekday WTPT features four hours of local programming from 6 AM to 10 AM. This includes a local news program that airs at 6 AM, 7 AM, 8 AM and 9 AM. The morning program also features interviews with community leaders, which provide information about events, services and programs that benefit the community.

Monday thru Saturday, the station features the 'community events calendar' with announcements about upcoming local events for churches or other non-profit organizations, plus local weather.

Every Saturday at 8:00 AM, WTPT features *Conversations with Paul Brown*. This is a 30-minute program hosted by longtime broadcaster, Paul Brown. During the 30-minute program different community leaders, or people of interest to the local community, are interviewed by Mr. Brown.
