

## COMMUNITY ISSUES FOR 1<sup>ST</sup> QUARTER 2013

- (1): NEED FUNDS IN RELIEF EFFORTS OF THE AMERICAN RED CROSS.
- (2): LOW INCOME RESIDENTS NEED ADVISED OF INEXPENSIVE LEGAL HELP.
- (3): HELP IN SECURING FOSTER HOMES AND ADOPTION SERVICES.
- (4): REMINDER OF ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE ILLINOIS SCENIC RIVER.
- (5): STORM SAFETY AWARENESS.

## **ANSWERS**

- (1): To help assist the American Red Cross in securing support in their Relief Efforts, we visited with Ryan Hardaway with the Red Cross on our Community Chat program which aired on KTLQ January 13<sup>th</sup>, from 9:00-9:15 am, and on KEOK January 16<sup>th</sup> from 9:15-9:30am.
- (2): Our Special Guests on Community Chat were George Fulk and Gayle Mcnamra, with Cherokee County Legal Services made available to low income residents who need assistance. This program aired on KTLQ January 31<sup>st</sup> from 9:00-9:15am, and on KEOK February 3<sup>rd</sup> from 9:15-9:30am.
- (3): Foster Homes for children are needed in Cherokee County as many are sent as far away as 2-hours due to lack of homes here, and there are 1,800 children available state wide available for adoption. On Community Chat, we visited with local contact, Becky Wright to publicize the need. This program aired on both February 7<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> on KTLQ from 9:00-9:15am and on February 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> on KEOK from 9:15-9:30 am.
- (4): Our local Illinois River, designated a Scenic River, accommodates a half million visits annually making a huge economic impact on this area. We discussed this and the needs to keep the river and area clean and regulated with Ed Fite, Illinois Scenic River Administrator on our Community Chat, on KTLQ February 27<sup>th</sup> from 9:00-9:15am and on KEOK March 3<sup>rd</sup> from 9:15-9:30am.
- (5): Living in what's termed "tornado alley", better information is needed to protect our citizens. KEOK and KTLQ have teamed-up with the Cherokee emergency Management which will allow us to broadcast live from their center in case of weather or other area emergency. We visited with Public Information Officer, Scott Pettus regarding our plans on Community Chat which aired on KTLQ March 21<sup>st</sup> from 9:00-9:15am and KEOK March 24<sup>th</sup> from 9:15-9:30am.
