**Outreach Activities**  
**For the period December 1, 2010 through November 30, 2011**

The management of KEVN-TV considers our employees KEVN's most valuable asset. KEVN-TV strives to have diversity among our staff in order to bring different ideas and perspectives to our organization. We believe that this makes KEVN-TV a better place to work and a better station for the communities we serve.

During the period covered by this report, KEVN-TV has provided on-the-job training designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher-level positions. Our Assistant Chief Engineer was promoted to Chief Engineer; he started out as a part time Production Assistant and moved up the ranks to Master Control Operator, Master Control Supervisor, IT Manager, Assistant Chief Engineer to Chief Engineer. A Production Assistant was promoted to a News Producer position; a Bench Tech was promoted to Assistant Chief Engineer; an intern was hired as a part-time News Reporter and promoted to a full time News Reporter when she graduated from college. It is the philosophy of the management of KEVN-TV to encourage employees to learn not only how to do their job, but also to learn and understand all aspects and departments of a television station and to realize their full potential for advancement.

On February 9, 2011, the Station Manager and Chief Engineer participated in the Western Dakota Tech Career Fair at the campus of Western Dakota Tech. They met with over 20 job candidates for various positions with KEVN-TV and interviewed two people for a Bench Tech position. On March 9, 2011, the Station Manager, News Director, Production Manager, Chief Engineer, Local Sales Manager and National Sales Manager participated in the Black Hills Regional Job Fair at the Rushmore Plaza Civic Center in Rapid City, South Dakota. Over 100 people visited our booth with 40 leaving applications and resumes with us. In 2011, KEVN-TV was a Platinum Sponsor of the Black Hills Regional Job Fair and aired over \$24,000 worth of commercials promoting the event. Our Station Manager currently volunteers his time to serve on the board that will plan, organize and oversee this major event for 2012.

In June 2011, one of KEVN's Account Executives spoke to the Youth Business Adventure class at Black Hills State University in Spearfish, S.D. about marketing plans, developing and producing a 30 second commercial. A student from Dakota State University spent the summer at KEVN-TV as an intern in our Production Department. KEVN's Sales Department had a Sturgis High School student job shadow an Account Executive to get a better understanding of television advertising and how it benefits each business in the Black Hills area. Several of KEVN's on air talent have made numerous visits to area schools to give talks about news and weather and careers in television. Jack Caudill, KEVN-TV News Director, volunteers as an instructor and mentor for Junior Achievement.

In February and May 2011, KEVN-TV and First Interstate Bank hosted the Rising Star of the West contest. Twenty area high school students competed for scholarships to the college of their choice by giving one-minute talks on topics of their choice on our nightly newscasts for four weeks in February. They were voted on by viewers online and a station panel of judges. Each week's winner then moved to the finalist round of presentations and voting in May. The first place winner won a \$4,000 scholarship, the second place winner won a \$2,000 scholarship, the third place winner won a \$1,000 scholarship and the forth place winner won a \$500 scholarship. This contest gave area high school students a chance to experience first hand what our News employees do every day.
