

**WZEW, WNXP, WZEW HD 2 (96.5 The Crab) &
WZEW HD 3 (92.5 The Soul) ISSUES and
PROGRAMMING TO ADDRESS THOSE
ISSUES, 3rd Quarter, 2020**

The following are the issues of public importance identified by radio station WZEW-FM in the 3rd Quarter of 2019 for Mobile, Fairhope and the surrounding service area:

- 1) The improvement and protection of the environment in Mobile and Baldwin counties along with Mobile Bay and the Gulf of Mexico.
- 2) The need for funding and support of the Child Advocacy Center for victims of sexual and physical abuse within the Mobile/Fairhope area.
- 3) Support for the American Heart Association, which provides education about cardiovascular conditions and resources for maintaining heart health.
- 4) The need for volunteer action to support programs and services for non-profit agencies within the service area.
- 5) Support for, and education about, the arts and the role they play in our community.
- 6) Updates daily on the Covid-19 Pandemic issues and information. We added 2 additional daily Corona Virus Update Reports on each station Monday – Friday, at 1PM and 3 PM, and on the weekends at 8 AM, 12PM, and 5PM.

WZEW-FM offers extended airtime to legitimate public service groups through our liberal offering of airtime to legitimate public service groups. Included in the 3rd quarter were the American Heart Association, the Child Advocacy Center, Childrens' of Alabama, the Lagniappe, Ronald McDonald House Charities,

United Cerebral Palsy, Mobile Arts Council, Mobile Bay Keeper, Mobile Theatre Guild, Mobile Shakespeare Company, Bra's Across the Causeway, The Joe Jefferson Playhouse and the Providence Hospital Foundation. All the PSA's that aired on WZEW are listed under separate cover in the public file.

Public News/Lagniappe

WZEW has dedicated time to supporting news efforts in partnership with the Lagniappe weekly newspaper to cover stories of public interest that go uncovered due to the area's lack of a daily newspaper.

American Heart Association

WZEW-FM promoted the "Heart Walk" event upcoming in August, a fundraiser benefiting the American Heart Association, though the event was postponed and done virtually November 14th due to Covid-19 Restrictions.. The AHA is one of the leading supporters of cardiovascular research nationwide.

Child Advocacy Center

WZEW-FM sponsored and promoted the Virtual "Cheers to Children" event, which featured a wine tasting, live music and a silent auction. All proceeds benefited the local Child Advocacy Center.

Ronald McDonald House Charities

WZEW-FM promoted the "Rubber Ducky Regatta," which was supposed to take place in August which benefited the local Ronald McDonald House Charities, but it was postponed until October 21st due to Covid 19 Restrictions. The RMHC provides resources for families and sick children.

United Cerebral Palsy

WZEW-FM promoted the Food and Folly Event September 19th that benefited United Cerebral Palsy. United Cerebral Palsy (UCP) educates, advocates and provides support services to ensure a life without limits for people with a spectrum of disabilities.

Mobile Bay Keeper

WZEW-FM sponsored and promoted the “Bay Bites Food Truck Festival,” an event featuring music, food vendors, a dunk tank and more benefiting Mobile Bay Keeper. Mobile Bay Keeper lobbies on a local, state and federal level to promote a cleaner environment in south Alabama. 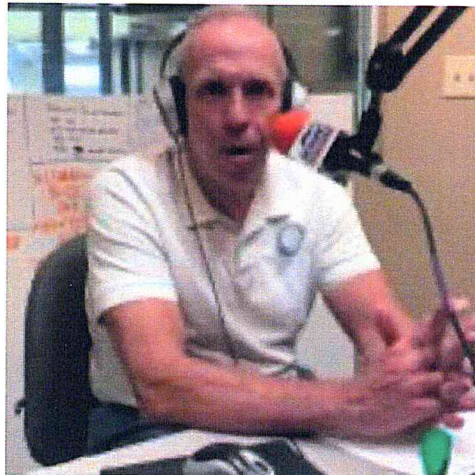
July 5, 2020

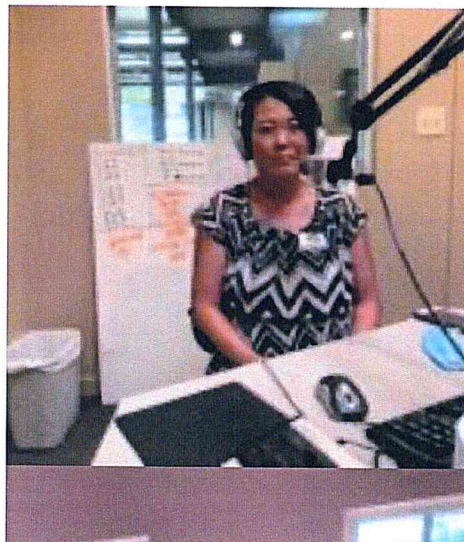
July 26, 2020

August 2, 2020

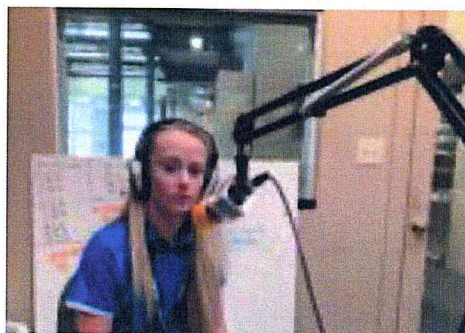

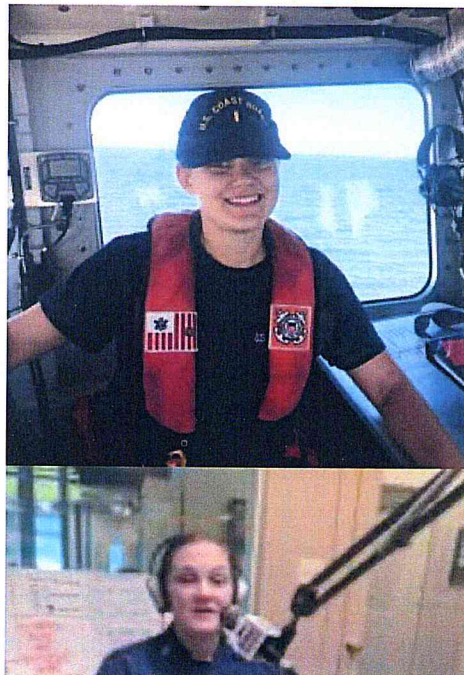

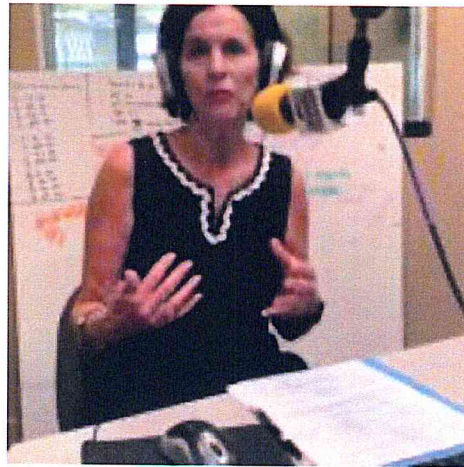
September 27, 2020

Our economy has taken a hit, due to this pandemic with many people looking for jobs for the first time in a long time.

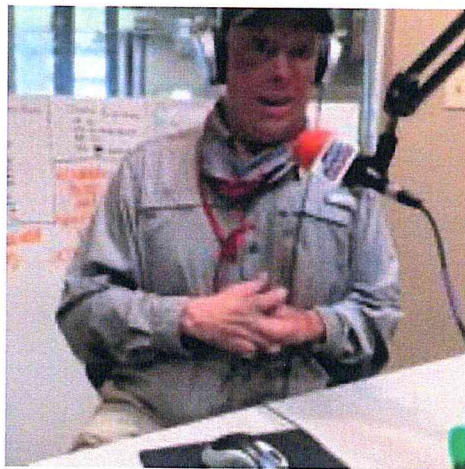
