November 2015

Issue: Increase community involvement in KLZR as well as KLZR service to the Wet Mountain Valley

Action: Survey of Board Members undertaken to identify issues and possible solutions.

November 2015

Issue: Increase youth involvement in the Community

Action: "Radio Rebels" trial is discussed and instituted as a trial program with the intention of bringing the program into the regular KLZR schedule if the teens and KLZR both agree it is a worthwhile program.

November 2015

Issue: Increase local involvement with KLZR and also enhance sense of community by instituting "Words on The Wind" program at KLZR.

Action: "Words on The Wind" was a production of the West Custer County library that had previously aired on the radio locally. KLZR agrees that it was a worthwhile program and commits to editing the previous broadcast files of "Words on The Wind," giving production credit to the West Custer County Library with the purpose of returning the program to the local airwaves. KLZR also commits to discussing the value of producing new "Words on The Wind" spots.

November 2015

Issue: Current lack of comprehensive plan to communicate emergency information to local residents

Action: KLZR forms "Emergency Broadcast Committee" with the intention of formulating comprehensive plan for the station to gather and broadcast information to the community in the case of emergencies.
