Program-“NewsMakers” – Interviews with government and community leaders on topics of concern to area residents. Airls 7 times per week at 6:30am & 10pm Mondays, 7pm Thursdays, 6:30am & 8pm Fridays, 10pm Saturdays, and 6:30pm Sundays.

- 1. Weeks of 12/31 & 1/7 – Dalton Mayor Dennis Mock and Councilman Gary Grews recap 2015 important events for city residents and look ahead for 2016.**
- 2. Weeks of 1/14 & 1/21 – On location at the Dalton Trade Center as State Representatives Tom Dickson and Bruce Broadrick discuss topics of concern in the 2016 Georgia Legislative session.**
