Supervised by one of our Production Managers, the interns' duties included basic audio editing for on-air use, work with social media, on-air time, and help with filing transmitter readings.

Established Internship Program (Initiative Number 5)	GBCC conducted an internship program in association with The Cristo Rey School of Baton Rouge to expose students to all aspects of the radio industry. We hosted two interns from Cristo Rey in the Production Departments in the Spring 2023. Supervised by our Human Resources Manager, the interns' duties included basic production, on-air time, and radio sales assistance.

The student is exposed to daily business and radio operations. The student is managed by one of our Production Managers and is learning video, production and editing skills.
