1 hour of Church programming each Sunday, 144 minutes of National news each day from CBS radio. 12 minutes of Newsopinion with the "Osgood File" each weekday, 8 editions of the "Michigan news Network" each day.

January 4th-WION borrowed a "bucket truck' from Reurink Roofing & Siding of Ionia to hoist a temporary FM antenna up to a height to keep our FM on the air after heavy rain/ice damaged the connection to our standard antenna.

January 5th--WION welcomed Ionia DDA director Linda Curtis to help us take a look ahead at the events planned for 2015 in the DDA district. Saturday March 14th--LIVE BROADCAST from Ionia High School for the annual Chamber of Commerce "Community Expo." We interviewed 18 different businesses, the Chamber Director, the Fire Department who put on a pancake breakfast, and general public who visited at our booth during the event.

March 16th--WION welcomed Mike Kennedy from Greenstone Farm Credit Services to talk about their "Patronage Day" this week, how Greenstone gives back to it's customers, and his involvement in the upcoming "Friends of Bertha Brock Park" fundraising night at the Steele Street Hall which will have Dinner, Live and Silent Auctions, and more. All Proceeds from this event go to the "Park Improvement Fund" at Bertha Brock Park, not to the general fund, making it even MORE important to have solid attendance.

Interviewed the School Sup't, the chamber director Liz Baker, Local Realtor with Greenridge Realty, and others. Duration: 6 hours of "remote" within the structure of usual programming.
