WION regularly carries:

“Town Hall News” (National and International) each hour, 24/7 Total: Over 48 minutes of National news each day of the week, actually more because some hours we record and air the full five minutes, not just the two minute news headlines.

Michigan News Network updates: 8 times each weekday including holiday, duration 3 minutes each edition aired. 24 minutes per weekday, 72 minutes per day.

LOCALLY PRODUCED (only) PSA announcements, one each hour, 24/7. **Duration: 1 minute each hour 24/7.**

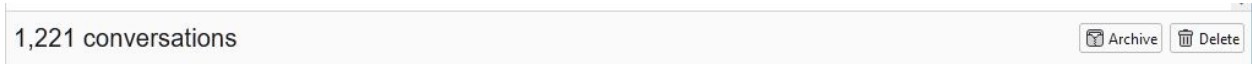
Feb14th....WION WELCOMED two representatives from Montcalm Community College speaking on the midday show about classes for summer, the MCC endowment and how it helps provide tuition for students and how some Michigan adults can attend college at no cost. Duration: 1 hour of conversation 10AM to 11AM during our usual midday show..

February 26th Jim ‘Carlyle’ discusses with listeners the *change in the 9-1-1 dispatch center using a new system called “Rapid SOS”* and the discontinuance of their “Smart 9-1-1” system. It is the opinion of the radio station that this is a bad move. Jim discussed the changes including the fact that the “new” system does not allow users to have unlimited contacts. The new system does not allow description of where utilities are on the affected address, and it does not allow description of pets, and other factors. Basically WION expressed the fact that based on facts presented...this is a downgrade to our county and should be reconsidered. Duration of Jim’s discussion: 10 minutes.

All Tuesdays: (9 to noon) “Text Topic Tuesdays” in which we take texts on topics suggested by listeners. Topics vary, are not “heavy” .

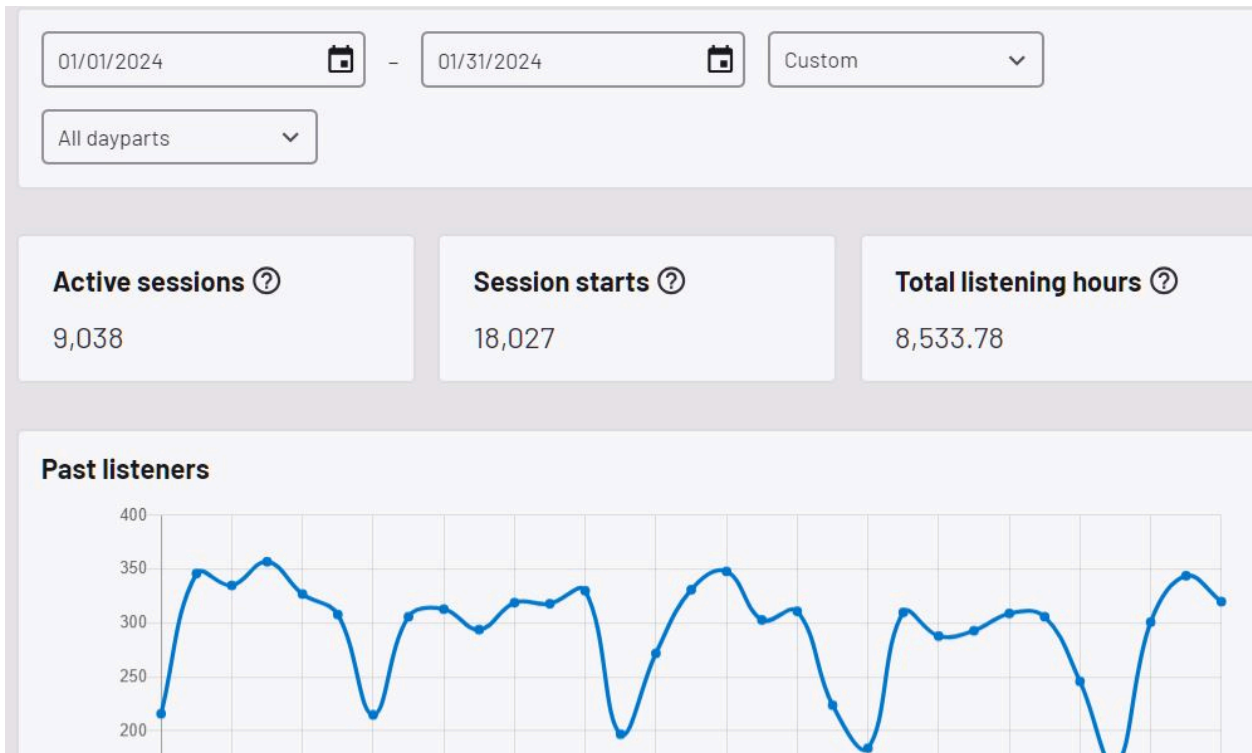
All Thursdays: “Mostly Request Thursdays” on our midday show.

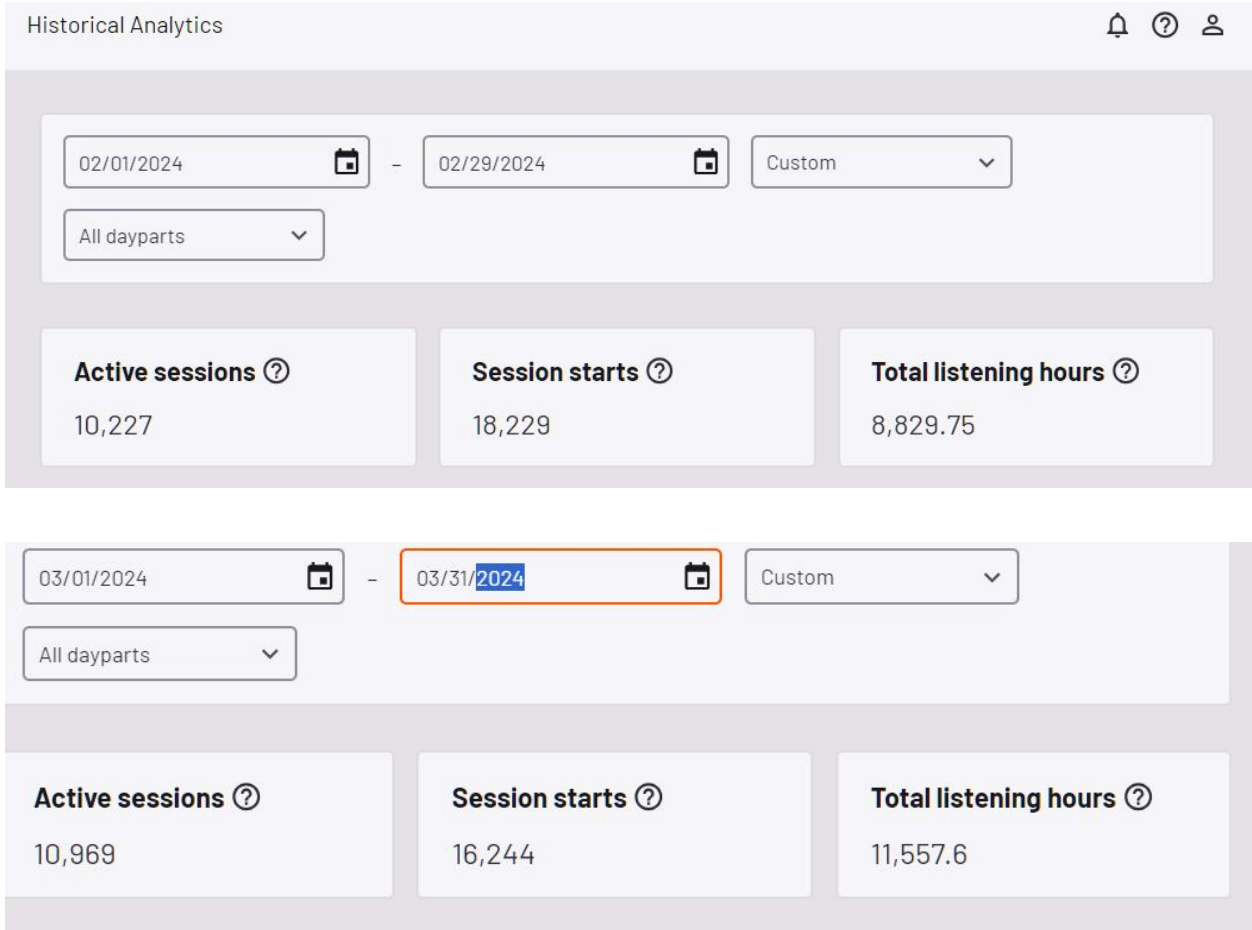
