- The Iowa caucuses take place tonight, with Donald Trump holding a commanding lead in all polling

JAN 16 Tuesday stories – Guest(s)

- Hour 1: · Donald Trump wins the Iowa caucus with 51% of the vote; more support than all competitors combined
- Results were announced in the Iowa caucus just 31-minutes after the caucuses started, raising questions about the press role in influencing the outcome
 - Vivek Ramaswamy attracted only 8% of the vote in Iowa, forcing him to drop out of the race for presidential nomination

Hour 2 · The top concern among voters in the Iowa caucus is illegal immigration

- NBC's Alex Wagner marvels at the turnout of White Evangelical Christians for Trump
 - MSNBC's Rachel Maddow refused to allow her listeners to hear Donald Trump's victory speech in Iowa, insisting it was a difficult decision the network revisits regularly in efforts to deny a platform to someone they assert is not truthful
 - CNN's Jake Tapper cuts the audio to the Donald Trump victory speech in Iowa, following his record-breaking victory winning 98 out of 99 counties in that state
 - Donald Trump makes myriad campaign promises during his Iowa caucus victory speech
