Re: Retransmission Consent Election

Dear Mr. Vocks:

We are in receipt of your letter dated February 24, 2015 providing notice that Computer Techniques, Inc. d/b/a CTI Fiber intends to initiate a video service in the Champaign-Decatur-Springfield Designated Market Area during 2015. Nexstar Broadcasting, Inc. is the licensee of television broadcast stations WCIA, Champaign and WCIA, Springfield (the Stations) both of which are assigned to the Champaign-Decatur-Springfield DMA. Please be advised that Nexstar hereby invokes its rights pursuant to Section 325(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 76.64(a) of the FCC's rules, to bar retransmission of the Stations' signal by your cable system(s) without our prior express written authority granted pursuant to a retransmission consent agreement to be negotiated between you and us.

This election is a continuing election from the date hereof through the initiation and provision of service by your systems. In addition, this election is made for each and every community or video service that CTI Fiber intends to serve in the Champaign-Decatur-Springfield DMA.

We look forward to negotiating a retransmission consent agreement with you for CTI Fiber's retransmission of WCIA and WCIX on its new system.
