Following President Barack Obama signing the Puerto Rico Oversight, Management, and Economic Stability Act (PROMESA) on June 30, the island experienced its largest single default to date. Faced with approximately \$2 billion in debt payments across a number of differing authorities, the island paid \$1.049 billion of \$2.008 billion due.
