WLOH aired the following programming to address these issues:

## 1-2023 Tax Season

In response to the annual tax law changes and a reverting back to pre- pandemic levels for child tax credits, WLOH aired "Tax Time Tuesdays" – 10 minute interviews with CPA Timothy Oatney of Oatney and Associates in Lancaster. These features aired Tuesdays between Noon and 1PM on January 10, 17, 24 and 31 - February 7, 14, 21 and 28, March 7, 14, 21 and 28.

Topics included the April 18<sup>th</sup> Filing Deadline, how to file an extension, State of Ohio Tax Laws, changes in the child care tax credits, frauds and scams, electronic filing and gift tax obligations.

## 2- Veterans Issues

WLOH aired weekly ten-minute interviews with the Chillicothe VA Medical Center. Topics covered included burn-pit exposure for veterans, extended coverage under the PACT Act, upcoming events for veterans in our area and open positions for employment at the VA. These interviews aired in the 4PM hour on February 14, 21, 28, March 7, 14, 21, 28. 3- Resources Available At Our Local Library

WLOH aired a weekly feature twelve minutes in duration that highlighted the available resources at the Fairfield County District Library. Library Director Becky Schaade discussed such matters as STEAM programs for children, the Garret Players production of 12 Angry Men, the Winter Reading Program and service changes due to ongoing elevator repairs at the main library. This feature aired from 7:00 AM to 7:12 AM on January 1, 7, 14, 21, 28 February 4, 11, 18, 25, March 4, 11, 18, 25.

4- Senior Health and Meals on Wheels Fundraising

WLOH aired a series of interviews ten minutes in duration with Anna Tobin – Executive Director of Meals on Wheels- Older Alternatives of Fairfield County. These segments aired on Wednesdays in the Noon Hour as part of our Noon DJ Show.

During this period, listeners were kept advised of weather related route cancellations, kitchen operations, congregate dining halls and the March 2023 "March For Meals" Fundraiser. This feature aired January4, 11, 18, 25, February 1, 8, 15, 22, March 1, 8, 15, 22, 29 2023.

In addition, WLOH broadcast a live event as a fundraiser for Meals on Wheels on Tuesday March 14<sup>th</sup> (Pie Day) where WLOH on air staff took pies to the face to raise money for the non-profit organization. This special feature aired from 10 to 10:15 AM on Tuesday March 14<sup>th</sup>.

## 5- Red Cross Blood Shortages

WLOH aired daily live PSA's addressing the blood shortage and identifying bloodmobile locations across the listening area. Approximately 100 live 30-second psa's were aired from 1-1-23 to 3-31-23.
