- A retired Army veteran is asked to leave a restaurant because his official service dog is with him. How will diners react?
- A cashier shames an elderly man for trying to pay for his groceries in coins. Will fellow shoppers in Picayune, Mississippi, stand up for the man?
- A man and woman are out on a first date. When the woman passes on a second meeting, her date insists they split the check. Will diners who overhear step in and take a side?
