### SUBJECT MATTER, ISSUES DISCUSSED:

We talked to Carol Wick, CEO of Harbor House of Central Florida. She talked about continuing problems with domestic violence in our area. Orlando is half the size of Miami but it has the same number of domestic violence cases. The need for services is up. Harbor House wants a new law to conceal the addresses of victims. They want to raise awareness of domestic violence and to get people to call police. They also want the justice system to do more to convict offenders. We talked to the organizers of EpisodeM, a mazda enthusiasts fundraiser that is raising money to help TEARS. The non profit group raises money to care for and help adopt pets from Seminole Co. Animal Services. We also talked to country music singer who will play at a cancer fundraiser. That event will support the Debbie Turner Cancer Care and Resource Center. Debbie had a ten year battle with brain cancer and started a non profit group in her city to help people with cancer.

**PUBLIC ISSUE: Orlando City Soccer Team and Stadium Debate**

### **SUBJECT MATTER, ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

We focused on the debate over a pro soccer team and stadium for Orlando. City of Orlando approved the plan but Orange Co. Commission will take the deciding vote on the plan on October 22<sup>nd</sup>. We talked to Orange Co Mayor Teresa Jacobs about her support for the plan. She says soccer is a growing sport and we cannot use the tax dollars in question for police, fire, schools and parks- they have to be used for projects like this. We talked to Orlando Mayor Buddy Dyer who says the project will create jobs and boost businesses near the stadium. He also says the city would own the stadium and rent it out to make money. We talked to Orlando City Soccer President Phil Rawlins, who says there would be an immediate economic boost that could last 30 years. He says people from around the world will come here to see soccer. Project critic Mike Cantone says if it's a great project, it should be financed all through private investors and none through govt. funds. He also claims the promises of an economic boom are overblown and he says there are 40 recent studies on similar stadiums across the country, that indicate that.

### SUBJECT MATTER, ISSUES DISCUSSED:

We did a two minute interview with former Governor Charlie Crist, asking if he is likely to run for Governor in 2014, what are his top issues, what will he do about Gov. Scott's fundraising advantage. We talked to a local economist and financial planner about the impact on local families and the economy of the Federal Government shutdown and the raising of the debt ceiling. He says lawmakers have to address the national debt problem soon so foreign investors do not lose confidence in our country. He said the shutdown was more emotion than actual serious fiscal impact because the Federal Govt. has huge revenue streams coming in all the time. We talked to a local pastor about next weekend's Promise Keepers event with six thousand people expected in Daytona Beach. They want local men to mentor fatherless men to reduce crime and other social problems. We also talked to organizers of the Winter Springs Festival of the Arts about the local artists displaying their work. There is also food and family fun.

He explained that they increase tourism visits for sports events in our area. They focus on Final Four competitions and other events that can go into the Amway Center, Citrus Bowl and the future soccer stadium. He talked about how the Citrus Bowl will continue to host Bowl games and monster truck events. He talked about the future of pro soccer in Orlando. He talked about March Madness coming to Orlando in 2014. He said much of the focus is on attracting Amateur Tournaments, where whole families visit our area, and then they also focus on Championship Tournaments, like events held at the Disney Wide World of Sports Complex. He talked about UCF's impressive run this year and how that brings in visitors and he said the future of a variety of sports events looks future in Central Florida.

We talked about the importance of screenings, exercise, proper diet and monitoring children's activities. We talked to the Camaraderie Foundation about their upcoming rucksack race, a fund raiser to help pay for counseling for veterans of Iraq and Afghanistan. We talked to a veteran wounded in combat about how the group has helped him. We talked about the services they provide and the need to help support the counseling they offer. We talked to Central Florida Kidney Centers about their efforts to help children with kidney diseases. The group has been doing that for forty years. The Orlando Magic will honor the group and children with kidney diseases Sunday at Magic game. We talked about research that found genetics cause many of the kidney diseases in children.

We talked to Best Buddies about their program that pairs up mentors with students with intellectual disabilities. Those mentors are friends, coaches, guides who make a difference in young lives. They are always looking for volunteers. We talked to See Art Orlando organizers. Private donors gave money to create eight sculptures in downtown Orlando. The idea is that the large sculptures make Orlando a more progressive, inviting place. An unveiling ceremony will be held on November 18<sup>th</sup>. Goodwill Industries is helping people with disabilities get jobs. They have eight centers in our area where people can donate items to sell and where people can get help with jobs. Good will hopes to open more centers and help more people get jobs in 2014. We also talked to a rep from St. Jude Children's Research Hospital in Memphis. The hospital helps children across America with diseases. We interviewed a local mom and her son about how St. Jude Hospital cured him of cancer. The group is having a walk in two weeks to raise funds to support their mission and there is time to get involved.

We talked to Ilene Wilkins with UCP of Central Florida about their seven campuses in our area. They have innnovative lessons and therapies to help students with a variety of disabilities. They put those students in classes with students who do not have disabilities so they can teach each other lessons. We also talked to State Rep. Ritch Workman of Melbourne. He talked about his controversial alimony reform bill and he talked about a bill to require that when governments buy American Flags, that they are made in America. He also talked about plans for a 500 million dollar tax cut next year, on license and cell phone fees and for business owners. He says House leadership wants him to find tax cuts that will reach as many Floridians as possible.

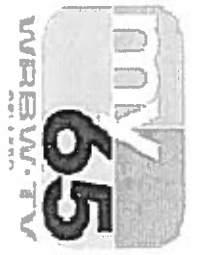
