Crime / Courts	4/3/23	8:00pm	1:35	Marion County Death Investigation	Three shooting victims in less than a week and all of them are teens. The Marion County Sheriff's Office believes the shootings are connected. FOX 35's Stephanie Buffamonte walks us through the timeline.

The Sheriff of Marion County was invited to speak about the issue on FOX News. He described the killings from suspects who are "wannabe" gangsters. It all started last week when a 16-year-old girl was found shot in the head and dumped near a trash bin. Another body was found nearby, and the third victim was found in a car that had sunk into a pond.

He served 32 years behind bars after accepting a plea deal to serve seven years of prison time for a murder he says he did not commit. Now, even after a Court of Appeals overturned his conviction, he will have to turn himself in and go back to prison. During their initial homicide investigation, Police wrote in their notes they believe Green was not responsible for the murder, but that the victim's girlfriend might be. That evidence was never turned over to Green's lawyers at the time, which is why he was finally allowed out of prison in 2021.
