SUBJECT MATTER, ISSUES DISCUSSED:

We interviewed state Senator Darren Soto, D Kissimmee about the expansion of Medicaid. He says there will be no special session to deal with it and business leaders and health leaders are calling on FL to accept 51 billion dollars from Fed. Govt. He says the house will face pressure to address this. He talked about concerns over water conservation, supplies and pollution and protection of our springs. He also talked about education reforms, changes in standardized tests and increasing funding for education. We talked to defense attorney Diana Tennis about the Zimmerman trial. She talked about main highlights of this week in court and what is likely to happen when the defense presents witnesses.

SUBJECT MATTER, ISSUES DISCUSSED:

We talked to the Seminole Co. Health Dept. about a rabies alert after six rabid animals in the county this year, including a bob cat that bit someone. We talked about ways to prevent contact with rabid animals and the need to get rabies shots if exposed. We also talked about amoeba dangers and immunizing children before they go back to school. We also talked to legal analyst Aramis Donell Ayala about the last days of the Zimmerman trial. We talked about the hearing over jury instructions, the closing arguments, some of the techniques the different lawyers used in the final days, and the attempt of the state to introduce a 3rd degree murder charge based on child abuse. We also talked about the state's burden of proof and how much evidence they put on.

SUBJECT MATTER, ISSUES DISCUSSED:

We talked about fallout from the Zimmerman trial and the effort to bring civil rights charges against George Zimmerman. We also talked about efforts to change FL Stand Your Ground Law and what the law really means. Analysts say there is not evidence for civil rights charges and Stand Your Ground is not likely to change. We talked to FOCUS, a federation of local churches. They are working to help people on issues like foreclosure, healthcare, immigration and more. We talked to Jill Walden with BASE Camp about efforts to help children with cancer. They will name a room at their new headquarters after Talia Castellano, who died this week, and became famous for video make up tutorials online. We also talked to DCF about changes in the way they investigate child abuse. They are encouraging a broader approach to investigations, more cooperation with law enforcement, and better career paths for DCF workers.

We talked to the Exec. Director of Christian Service Center, which helps local families struggling with foreclosure, hunger, large bills and other social service issues. They see a strong need for help still. They also have a Love Pantry in 60 Orange County schools, to make sure students are not hungry. They need volunteers. We talked to Pastor Derrick Gay, A Sanford pastor, launching a racial reconciliation effort after the Zimmerman trial. It will start with a meeting in Sanford and they hope to take it nationwide. We also talked to the Sharing Center and HOPE Helps, two groups that provide social services for struggling families and still see a strong need for services. They need volunteers. They are working on a back to school event to make sure students have what they need to start school.

We talked to former Supt. of Schools in Seminole County, Dr. Bill Vogel. We also talked to the founder of Fund Education Now, Kathleen Oropeza. It's a grass roots group that gives parents say in education issues and policies across Florida. We talked about the recently issued FCAT school grades which were down this year and how the state made the standards harder. We talked about parents building relationships with teachers and school boards. We talked about concerns over new common core national accountability standards, and questions about the PARK test that goes with it. We talked about how districts are struggling to write end of course exams and to make sure schools have good enough technology to move away from text books to digital curriculum. We also interviewed Justine Cowan about the Community Legal Services of Mid Florida, which offers free legal services on a wide variety of issues. They have a new useful website coming out and they say they are seeing people lose lots of money to companies, which promise to help save your home from foreclosure and people end up losing the home after paying high fees to the company.
