She was knocked unconscious, badly hurt, and needed to be rushed to a hospital. We told viewers this whole thing started when the teacher's aide took away the suspect's hand-held video game console while he was in class. He is facing numerous charges. We have reported on a number of incidents of violence in Flagler County and this story happened in our viewing market. |

This story impacted the entire Pine Hills community, as a major part of it was locked down. Violent crime has been plaguing the area for a while.
