48 HOURS: "The Final Hours of Cayley Mandadi" - a report on the murder of Trinity University student Cayley Mandadi, allegedly by one of the two men she was involved with. In October 2017, Cayley Mandadi was rushed to the emergency room in Luling, TX by Mark Howerton, a man she had been having a relationship with. After leaving a San Antonio music festival on October 29th and having sex, Mark claimed she stopped breathing. Medical staff were unable to revive Cayley. Three months later, an autopsy concluded she had died from blunt force trauma to the face and head, leading to Mark's arrest for murder and sexual assault. At trial, the prosecution presented witnesses from the night at the emergency room that noted bruises on Cayley's legs and redness on Mark's hands, and cited the fact that Mark had changed his story about where he and Cayley had sex. Friends of Cayley and a Trinity University security officer testified about Mark's violent outbursts, including an incident that led to him being barred from campus. Jett Birchum, the other man Cayley had been involved with, testified that Cayley had agreed to break up with Mark at the music festival and that he witnessed Mark forcing her to leave with him. Mark's attorney, John Hunter, questioned Jett's credibility as he had given different testimony in court than he had to police and the grand jury. He also pressed Jett on the immunity deal he made with prosecutors over Jett's alleged involvement in dealing drugs. Defense witnesses rebuked the autopsy; a forensic pathologist stated a skull fracture was consistent with a fall and a pharmacology expert testified that the large amount of MDMA in Cayley's system could have led to hemorrhages and bruising. After 10 hours of deliberation over two days, a mistrial was declared. However, the prosecution plans to retry the case. Alison Steele, Cayley's mother, worked to pass the CLEAR alert bill in Texas, which allows for emergency texts for missing persons between 18 and 64. 48 HOURS: "Justice for Ahmaud" - a report on the shooting death of Ahmaud Arbery, which led to widespread national outrage after video of the incident was released. On February 23, 2020, Ahmaud Arbery went running in the Satilla Shores neighborhood of Brunswick, GA. During that time, he went inside a home under construction, which led to a neighbor calling 911 to report a trespasser. Another neighbor, Greg McMichaels, and his son, Travis, decided to follow Ahmaud in their truck. Ahmaud fled when they confronted him. Soon Roddie Bryan also joined the pursuit, and the McMichaels were able to box Ahmaud in. As Ahmaud attempted to run past Travis, a confrontation ensued, which resulted in Ahmaud being fatally shot. First responders arrived within minutes and allowed all three men to go free. Police contacted Ahmaud's mother, Wanda Cooper-Jones, and stated that he was killed during a break-in. She would learn the truth after it was published in the paper. Two district attorneys recused themselves from the case afterwards due to ties with Greg, who was a former police officer. In May 2020, video of the incident was released and led to widespread condemnation and protests. Greg, Travis, and Roddie would subsequently be arrested. At a preliminary hearing, defense attorneys portrayed Ahmaud as the aggressor and cited a previous mental illness diagnosis of his, while dismissing any accusation of racism. However, investigators from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation revealed numerous texts including the N-word from Travis. At Roddy's arraignment hearing in July 2020, he claimed to have been only a witness to the shooting and denied any involvement, despite Ahmaud's handprint being found on his truck. 48 HOURS: "Christy Martin - The Fight of Her Life" - boxer Christy Martin opens up about the attack from her former husband that nearly ended her life. In November 2010, Christy Martin told her husband and long-time boxing trainer, Jim Martin, that she would be seeking a divorce. Christy had reconnected with her high school girlfriend, Sherry Lusk, and no longer wished to live in the closet. Days later, Jim approached Christy with a concealed knife as she prepared for a workout. In the ensuing confrontation, Jim stabbed Christy multiple times and shot her near her heart. Jim believed her to be dead, but Christy survived and was able to make it outside where she found Rick Cole, a passing driver who took her to the emergency room. Jim went on the run and was found seven days later living in a neighbor's shed. In April 2012, Jim's trial began in Orlando, FL. Witnesses for the prosecution testified to Jim's history of controlling and abusing Christy. In contrast, Jim's defense attorney, Bill Hancock, portrayed Christy as the aggressor and claimed that the injuries she suffered were the result of her attacking Jim and Jim defending himself. The jury found Jim guilty of attempted murder. He was sentenced to 25 years in prison.
