Pursuant to your audit letter dated February 8, 2017, Christian Television Corporation, Inc. ("CTC") hereby submits this response regarding the Equal Employment Opportunity ("EEO") program at its station WVUP-CD, Tallahassee, FL. This letter's responses follow the outline of your request.

1. WVUP-CD is the only station in its station employment unit ("SEU"). CTC employs fewer than five full-time employees at the station. Therefore, CTC is not required to have an EEO recruitment program and will only be responding to Questions 2 and 3(e) of the audit letter, as directed. Further, WVUP-CD is not subject to a time brokerage agreement; therefore, CTC is not required to respond to Question 4.
