**Catholic Outreach:** Grand Valley Catholic Outreach is the collaborative effort of many churches and individuals offering emergency services to people in need with the help of over 500 volunteer.

**Veteran's Craft Center:** First established in 1971, Help Heal Veterans has provided free therapeutic arts and crafts kits to hospitalized and homebound veterans for generations.

**Communities in Schools:** Communities In Schools works directly inside schools, building relationships that empower students to succeed inside and outside the classroom.

**Dolphin House:** The Dolphin House is a child-friendly, safe facility whose purpose it to provide your child with a place for telling a difficult story during a necessary investigation of child abuse and offer supportive counseling to the parents and their children.

**Ariel Clinical Services:** To provide safe, nurturing and supportive environments for our clients with disabilities so that they may have the opportunities to develop their strengths, maximize their potentials and fully participate in society.

**Water Conservation:** The Colorado Water Conservation Board (**CWCB**) represents each major water basin, Denver and other state agencies in their joint effort to use water wisely and protect our water for future generations.

**Stand up to Cancer:** Stand Up To Cancer raises funds to accelerate the pace of groundbreaking research that can get new therapies to patients quickly, facilitating collaboration among the best and brightest scientists and physicians. SU2C draws on the entertainment community to build public support for this effort.

The House helps these teens move towards stable and safe housing and other youth-driven goals through intensive case management and support from advocates, volunteers, and mentors.

Colorado Adaptive Sports: The Colorado Adaptive Sports Foundation (CASF) aims to bolster independence, improve self-confidence, elevate social interaction and enhance quality of life through organized team sports. CASF is for people of all ages throughout Colorado who have physical disabilities including spinal cord injuries, spina-bifida, amputations and cerebral palsy.
