WDOR AM & FM program, "Today's Talkshow," is simulcast from 10:20AM to 11AM, Monday through Friday. There are regular guests each month plus occasional guests for special events. The audience is invited to call in with questions or comments which are broadcast live. Callers do not have to identify themselves.




