California Gov. Jerry Brown's veto of a bill that would have allowed San Francisco to open the nation's first sanctioned safe injection site disappointed advocates and paused one experimental effort to fight the opioid epidemic.

US Secretary of State Mike Pompeo says progress on the North Korean nuclear program has been made during his trip to east Asia. There had been little movement since a historic June meeting between Trump and Kim Jong Un.

Trump has threatened to order the military to close the US-Mexico border to stop an "onslaught" of migrants. Mexico itself geared up for the arrival of up to 3,000 people from Honduras on its border.

Several thousand Central American migrants who managed to cross from Guatemala into Mexico have vowed to continue marching toward the US. President Donald Trump has politicized the caravan ahead of the midterm elections.
