Dear Ms. Dortch:

Greg Combs, d/b/a Providential Broadcasting ("Providential"), by its counsel, respectfully requests an extension of Special Temporary Authority ("STA"), originally granted on November 22, 2021 (File No. BESTA-20211109AAF) and most recently extended on May 26, 2022 (File No. BESTA-20220520AAF), to allow WXRQ(AM), Mount Pleasant, Tennessee (Facility No. 48497) ("Station") to continue to operate with parameters at variance from the terms of its license.

As previously reported to the Commission, in July 2019, the Station lost access to its longtime rented transmitter site following the death of the property owner. Since that time, the Station has been operating with a "long wire" antenna, as set forth in the Engineering Report included with File No. BSTA-20200326AAA. The Station intends to operate on this temporary basis until a new tower site can be secured for the Station.

Over the past few months, Providential has reached a preliminary agreement with the owner of a nearby location that would allow a new tower (approximately 120 feet above ground level) to be constructed. At this time, Providential is in the process of hiring an engineering firm to perform the required environmental study and has raised funds to build the new tower. Ultimately, before the new tower can be erected, Providential must obtain approval from the County. Preliminary meetings have gone well, and Providential will keep the Commission apprised as to its progress.

In the meantime, until the new tower is built, a grant of this STA extension request is in the public interest because it would allow the Station to remain on the air at all times, broadcasting Ms. Marlene H. Dortch, Secretary November 22, 2022 Page 2
