**NOTIFICATION OF TEMPORARY  
REDUCTION IN OPERATING POWER**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of **MonsterMedia, LLC ("MonsterMedia")**, Licensee of **Radio Station KLJZ-FM at Yuma, Arizona**, we hereby provide §73.1560 notification that KLJZ-FM is currently operating at reduced power. In support hereof, MonsterMedia submits the following:

1. On March 9, 2019, KLJZ-FM began reduced power operations as a result of the failure of the station's transformer. KLJZ-FM is now operating with an ERP of 10 kilowatts instead of the 100 kilowatts authorized by its FCC license.
2. MonsterMedia has ordered a replacement transformer but it is not scheduled to arrive until later this month.
3. In the event these reduced power operations need to continue past April 8, 2019 the requisite Request for Special Temporary Authority will be filed prior to that date.
