ABC Action News – WFTS produces daily newscasts providing local information of interest to viewers in the Tampa Bay area. Through conversations with community stake holders, WFTS identifies those topics having the greatest impact on the community. WFTS produces 41 hours of local news each week. This includes reports on subjects such as crime, health, government, education, consumer news. Regularly scheduled newscasts air M-F 5:00am-7:00am, 9:00am -10:00am, 3:00pm-4:00pm, 4:00pm – 5:00pm, 5:00pm -6:00 pm, 6:00pm -6:30pm & 11:00pm - 11:35pm. On weekends, the station has regularly scheduled newscasts Sat 7:00am – 8:00am, 9:00am – 10:00am, 6:00pm – 6:30pm, & 11:00 – 11:30pm. The Saturday 6:00 pm newscast may periodically be preempted by ABC sports. On Sunday, local newscasts are 6:00am – 7:00am, 8:00am – 9:00am, 6:00pm – 6:30pm, and 11:00pm – 11:30pm.

I-Team Special Reports – WFTS regularly produces investigative reports that air in the 11pm newscasts. These reports provide in-depth information on topics that are of interest to the Tampa Bay viewing area.

Coggins, a young black man, was brutally murdered in 1983 in a small Georgia town due, in part, to his relationship with a white woman. When both state and local authorities stopped investigating and the Coggins family received threats to remain quiet, the case went cold for nearly 35 years. In 2017, the Spalding County Sheriff's Office and the Georgia Bureau of Investigation reopened the cold case and eventually charged Frankie Gebhardt and William Moore Sr. with Coggins' murder.

Diane Downs

A mother's infatuation with a married man who said he had no interest in being a father to anyone's children was the possible motive behind the crimes of Diane Downs, who shot her three young children in her car, seriously injuring two and killing one. Diane captured the nation's attention as the story made headlines and became a bestselling book and a two-part TV series starring Farrah Fawcett, both titled "Small Sacrifices." Now, 36 years after that tragic day, Diane's youngest child, Becky Babcock, who was born while Diane was incarcerated and adopted by another family, speaks to "20/20" in a new interview. Lisa Stasi and her 4-month-old daughter, Tiffany, mysteriously vanished in Kansas City, Missouri in 1985. When police charged serial killer John Robinson in 2000 with murdering Stasi, discovered John took Tiffany, forged adoption papers and gave her to his brother and sister-in-law who, knowing nothing of the true circumstances, thought it was a legal adoption and renamed her Heather Tiffany Robinson. Over a period of six months in 2010, posing as Chris Smith, Shin told the 31-year-old's loved ones, friends and colleague that he had [sold his share of the ad company](#) the two founded and was living out his dream traveling the world. Police say that for about year Shin managed to dupe almost everyone. Shin, now 42, later confessed to accidentally killing Smith, but he has denied he intentionally murdered him. (OAD: 1/24/20)

Friday, August 14, 2020 (9:01-11:00PM ET)

Texas Love Triangle

David Temple claimed he discovered his eight-month-pregnant wife, Belinda Temple, shot dead inside their home. Despite two murder trials and two juries finding David guilty of Belinda's murder, he's once again awaiting sentencing, 20 years after her death. Belinda's family is also waiting for justice decades after the terrible tragedy changed their lives forever. "20/20" correspondent Deborah Roberts reports extensively following David's most recent trial and reports on a twist in the case. (OAD: 11/01/19)

One Night in Central Park

Trisha Meili was viciously beaten, raped and left to die inside New York City's Central Park. The series of events that followed, triggered a media frenzy and forever changed the lives of all involved, including the five African American and Hispanic teenagers – Raymond Santana, Antron McCray, Yusef Salaam, Kevin Richardson and Korey Wise – who were convicted in the attack due to their confessions, which they said were coerced by police. Their verdicts were later set aside after Matias Reyes confessed to and was convicted in the attack. Growing Up Buttafuoco

Nearly three decades ago, then 17-year-old Amy Fisher – dubbed “Long Island Lolita” by media – shot Mary Jo Buttafuoco on her front porch following an affair with her husband, Joey Buttafuoco. Life in Prison: Melanie McGuire

In a new episode of “20/20,” co-anchor Amy Robach sits down for the first on-camera interview with Melanie McGuire since she was sentenced to life in prison 13 years ago in New Jersey for the murder of her husband, Bill McGuire. Authorities arrested McGuire, dubbed by the media as the “suitcase killer,” after Bill's remains appeared inside multiple suitcases in the Chesapeake Bay. McGuire opens up to Robach about the murder and maintains her innocence.

WHAT WOULD YOU DO?

Tuesday, July 7, 2020 (Season Premiere)

- A white man enters a restaurant wearing a jacket with the Confederate flag on it. Nearby, a Black customer sees the jacket and politely asks the man to remove the jacket, saying he finds the symbol offensive. The white man refuses to remove the jacket, saying he has the right to wear what he wants. How will diners in Mississippi react when they overhear this? How will customers react in New York when the same scene is played out?
- A man experiencing homelessness is buying a cup of coffee in a coffee shop when the cashier offers to give him some free food. The manager overhears and berates the cashier for her actions. How will bystanders react as the tension increases?
- Two young men are viewing risqué photos of a woman. One of the men, the woman's jilted ex-boyfriend, talks to his friend about getting back at his ex for breaking up with him. He explains that he's going to post intimate photos – that she shared only with him – online for the world to see. How will those who overhear the conversation react to his planned actions, known as revenge porn which is considered a crime in many states?
- A mother and her young son are shopping in a clothing store; the boy is dressed in a full superhero costume and is trying to enlist other customers to help him in his quest to destroy evil. The mother becomes embarrassed and annoyed by what she claims is the child's overactive imagination. Will other shoppers say something to the mother trying to rein in her child's creativity?

Tuesday, July 14, 2020

- A high school student is out for a meal with his coach and after building up the courage, he finally tells his coach he's gay and says he wants to come out to his teammates, too. The coach advises him not to come out, saying it would ruin his chances of becoming a professional baseball player. Rippon watches with Quiñones behind the scenes and reflects on his own experiences as the first openly gay Winter Olympian to represent Team USA and win a medal for the United States.
- A veteran who suffered a traumatic brain injury (TBI) is struggling to order food in a restaurant. He apologizes to the staff and explains that he suffers from a brain injury which causes his hands to shake and limits his ability to make decisions. The rude waitress requests that the veteran moves faster and even questions whether he is drunk. Will other diners come to his aid? A veteran from the Disabled American Veterans organization helps inform the scenario behind the scenes by sharing his experiences with a TBI.
- A customer in a clothing store, claiming to be inspired by Marie Kondo's KonMari Method, deviates from Kondo's positive message as she begins to reorganize the store, removing items from the shelves and tossing them in piles on the floor. What will customers say when she tries to enlist their help?
- A father is out to lunch with his son and the father asks to borrow money so he can gamble. The conversation quickly turns into an intervention as the young man tells his dad that his gambling addiction is ruining the family. How will others who overhear react?
- As food and income inequality grows across the country, many families are forced to shop for the least expensive items at the supermarket. A mother is with her child in a Mississippi supermarket. As she purchases foods at reduced prices, another shopper begins to criticize her choices. What will shoppers do?

Tuesday, July 21, 2020

- A woman is at a restaurant by the United States-Mexico border in El Paso, Texas, with a young immigrant child, whom she is sponsoring in an effort to keep the child out of a detention center. Another diner objects, arguing that the woman's efforts should be focused on American children who need help. How will bystanders react?
- When a new mother meets her friend out for lunch, she reveals she's feeling extremely low and overwhelmed by motherhood – signs of postpartum depression and anxiety. Instead of empathizing, the friend minimizes the mother's feelings and suggests that all she needs is a glass of wine and a bubble bath. How will those who overhear the conversation react? Will bystanders' reactions vary if the friend is replaced with the new mother's husband? Haines joins this emotional scenario and steps in to play the role of the new mom.
- Two college sorority members are at a café when they run into their classmate, a young woman with Down syndrome, whom their sorority recently rejected. The young woman asks if she could try to join again next year, but the sorority sisters tell her that she can't be in their house because she's different. Will others come to the defense of this young woman?
- A grandfather wants to go zip lining with his granddaughter in Campton, Kentucky. As they start to sign waivers before participating, the granddaughter becomes nervous due to her grandfather's heart condition. The grandfather shakes off her worries, telling her that zip lining is on his bucket list. What will others do?

Tuesday, July 28, 2020

- When a young woman applies for a job at a café, the manager points out that she didn't fill out a home address on her application. She explains that she isn't sure where she'll be living as she is soon due to age out of foster care. The teenager emphasizes that she is responsible, but the manager tells her she can't take any chances and needs to hire someone that is reliable. How will people nearby react?
- A woman is out on a date with an Asian man. The date seems to be going well, but then the woman stereotypes her date as smart, asking him, "Can you just imagine if we had children? They would be so attractive and smart!" How will those who overhear the conversation respond? Will bystanders' reactions change if a Black actor plays the woman's date and she stereotypes him as athletic?
- At a bar, a wife pressures her husband to have a drink with her. The husband shares that he's decided to try a period of sobriety after becoming concerned he has issues with alcohol. His wife accuses him of not being any fun. Will others say something when they overhear the conversation? Actor Ben Curtis, famous for having been "The Dell Dude" and a veteran "What Would You Do?" actor, plays the part of the husband and shares his own story of sobriety.
- A bride-to-be asks one of her bridesmaids to meet her for lunch. However, their conversation sours when the woman tells her bridesmaid she's been kicked out of the wedding. The bride argues that her friend is not fulfilling her duties as a bridesmaid, so she would like her to step down and hand in her dress. Will people nearby side with the bride or bridesmaid?
- A mother and her 12-year-old son are setting up for the child's birthday party at a restaurant. After time passes, the mother realizes that none of her son's classmates are showing up to the party. The mother explains to the waitress about all the classmates she invited and the invitations she sent out.

Tuesday, August 4, 2020

- A student is out to lunch with a friend, explaining that in order to pay for college she has decided to become a sugar baby, providing companionship to men in return for gifts, money and other benefits as compensation. Her friend worries that this choice is risky. Who will other diners side with?
- When a woman out shopping is informed that the dress she wants is not available in her size, she bursts into tears. How will other customers respond to her public display of emotions? What will customers do if a man gets emotional in public?
- Two women at a restaurant belittle a stay-at-home dad, condescendingly asking if his unusual choice to stay home with his daughter makes him feel emasculated. What will fellow diners say? How will people react if the women are replaced with two men?
- A woman babysitting two young children brings them to a bar for lunch. She expresses she is overwhelmed by her job and decides a drink will help her cope. When one drink turns into multiple, what will others say? Will they step in when she tries to leave to drive the children home?
- A teacher is in a store shopping for food for herself and basic school supplies for her class. Her credit card is denied at the register and she removes food from her cart instead of school supplies, explaining that her students need them. What will other shoppers do? (OAD: 9/7/18)

Tuesday, August 11, 2020

- A middle-aged woman walks into a bar to apply for an open bartending position. The on-duty manager makes it clear the woman doesn't have "the right look." When pressed, the manager admits she believes the woman is simply too old to work at the bar. How will customers react? What will people say if a middle-aged man is the one turned away? Foster joins in on the action behind the scenes.
- Two women in a gym shame a larger woman for wearing workout leggings. The scenario is re-done, this time with the bullies shaming a woman for being too skinny for her form-fitting pants. Will other gym goers stand up for the woman being bullied?
- A gay couple is at a sporting goods store shopping for apparel for football season. A fellow shopper rudely tells the couple "this is a man's sport" and "you two are not welcome in the bleachers near me." Will bystanders speak out against this man's remarks?
- A mother is demanding her children eat their vegetables at a restaurant. When the children refuse, the mom says that they cannot get up until they clean their plates. What will others say? What if the mother steps away and the children plot to get rid of the vegetables? Will others help them?

Tuesday, August 18, 2020

- An unvaccinated teenager, worried he's going to get sick, pleads with his mother to let him get a vaccine, but she is against it. How will people react when she refuses to give him permission?
- A mother at the checkout line tries to come up with the cash to buy baby formula and diapers. When the cashier steps away and the till is left open, the woman steals money out of the register. What will others in

line do? In a twist, how will people react if the woman stealing money appears to have the means to afford her items but claims she forgot her wallet in the car?

- A pageant coach is berating her contestant and harshly criticizing her appearance. How will bystanders react?
- A child at an alligator farm in Gibson, Louisiana, tells his father that he is too afraid to hold a baby alligator. The father is disappointed in his son and tells the boy he should “act like a man.” How will others visiting the farm react?
- An older man is eating alone at a restaurant he frequently visited with a friend. When the waitress notices he’s alone, she learns that the man’s friend recently passed away. Will other diners who overhear the sad news sit with him and keep him company?

Tuesday, August 25, 2020

- Immigration status. He tells the men that until there is a border wall, there is no way of knowing who is in the United States legally. How will others who witness the conversation react in New Jersey? What will the reaction be in El Paso, Texas, just a few miles from the U.S.-Mexico border?
- A group of teen girls is verbally bullying a classmate at a park. What will witnesses do? Will they defend the young woman or ignore the situation? Jax joins Quiñones behind the scenes and opens up about her own story of overcoming bullying and finding self-confidence.
- A woman and her son are waiting at a diner for her ex-husband to pick up the child. While waiting, the woman repeatedly says negative things about her ex. As the child becomes visibly upset will others do something? What will fellow diners say if the scene switches and a father criticizes his ex-wife?
- A customer in a barbershop falls asleep in the chair, making it impossible for the barber to do his job and delaying other customers’ appointments. How will people react? What will bystanders do if a customer falls asleep in a nail salon while getting a pedicure? How will diners respond if a child falls asleep in his food while his mother takes a call?

Tuesday, September 8, 2020 (9:00 -11:00PM ET – Season Finale)

What Would You Do? scenarios airing at 9:00 p.m. EDT include the following:

- A young man comes out to his friends as bisexual. His friends question his sexual orientation saying, “You can just say you’re gay. You don’t have to hide behind bisexuality.” What will bystanders do? How will people react when we twist the scenario and the friend questioning his bisexuality is gay?
- At the batting cages, a girl is trying to better her baseball game. Her father disapproves, telling her, “Girls don’t play baseball.” The girl is determined to prove to her dad that she can compete with the boys. Will others come to her defense?
- A newly engaged woman is out to lunch with her friend, showing off her ring. The friend is appalled at how small the diamond is. Will fellow diners step in to stop the bullying?
- Two grandmothers are out to lunch with their granddaughters. As the grandmothers start posing for photos and posting them to social media, the granddaughters become embarrassed and beg them to act their age. The grandmothers refuse. Whose side will fellow diners take?

Would You Lie For Me? scenarios airing at 10:00 p.m. EDT include the following:

- A young boy at an ice cream shop needs help fending off bullies. After bystanders agree to help him, the boy tells his bullies, “This is my karate instructor.” Will they go along with the fib? Will they still support the boy later when he takes a bolt cutter to a locked bike?
- A focus group is reviewing a product that does not work. When they overhear the other participants lying about the product’s effectiveness, will they lie too? The salesman then asks if they will pretend to be a marriage coach for an uncomfortable meeting with his wife. Will anyone agree? If they do, will they give marriage advice?
- A woman in a restaurant is waiting for her meddling mother who is in town for the weekend. To keep her mom off her back, the woman asks total strangers to pretend to be her boyfriend. Will they say yes? If they agree, how far will they take the lie when the mother asks them about their job as a cardiologist? This scenario originally aired on “What Would You Do?” and inspired the primetime special.
