Friday, July 7, 2023

Wave of Deceit

Texas housewife Laura Day seemed to have it all: a large home on the water, a loving marriage with her husband, David Syring, and a close relationship with her 6-year-old stepson, Taylor Syring. But, when Taylor drowned on a beach trip with Day under suspicious circumstances, police discovered her shocking criminal past, and the façade of her picture-perfect life quickly came crashing down. A two-hour “20/20,” in collaboration with Plum Pictures, features ABC News anchor John Quiñones’ interview with Day from prison, nearly a decade after her first-degree capital murder conviction for Taylor’s death. In the interview, Day opens up about what she claims really happened that day and her past crimes of bigamy and murder while also maintaining her innocence in Taylor’s death, alleging it was an accident. Friday, July 14, 2023

Truth and Lies: The Family Manson

It was one of the most gruesome crime sprees of the 20th century that shocked and haunted the nation. As Leslie Van Houten is released from prison this week, “20/20” explores Charles Manson, his cult of devoted followers and the grisly murders in Los Angeles that he instructed his members to carry out. Amidst an era of sex, drugs and rock and roll in 1969, Manson’s followers killed seven people in two consecutive nights, including actress Sharon Tate, who was more than eight months pregnant at the time, in the home she shared with her husband, Roman Polanski. The terrifying and violent acts instantaneously eliminated a sense of safety and security for many people across the country. After serving 53 years for her role in the murders, Leslie Van Houten, a former cult member, was released from prison this week. This episode includes ABC News’ interview with Van Houten from her time in prison and takes a look at the details surrounding her release. The program includes footage from ABC News’ interviews with Manson, in his last network television interview from prison, and former cult member Patricia Krenwinkel, who is serving a life sentence for the murders masterminded by Manson. The documentary explores the crime scene footage and features interviews with law enforcement, first responders and the production crew who met Manson during his final TV interview. The special also features interviews with Debra Tate, Sharon Tate’s sister; family and friends of the victims; actors who worked with Sharon; Mike Love of the Beach Boys, who met Manson before the killings; reporters who were in the courtroom during the trial and more. Friday, July 21, 2023

The Dating Game Killer

In 1968, Rodney Alcala lured a young girl outside the iconic Chateau Marmont hotel in Hollywood and into his car, which marked the beginning of his reign of cross-country attacks that spanned over a decade. Posing as a professional photographer, Alcala often used his good looks and charm to trap his victims. But perhaps his most brazen move came in 1978 when he made a chilling appearance as a contestant on the hit show “The Dating Game” and won. Through first-hand accounts from investigators, victims, eyewitnesses and even his court-appointed psychologist, “20/20” reports on one of the most notorious serial killers of modern times. Friday, July 28, 2023

Home Sweet Murder

When Mark and Shaun Staudte fell ill and died suddenly within months of each other, it seemed as though the Missouri family experienced a spurt of horrible luck. When Sarah Staudte developed similar symptoms soon after, landing her in the hospital, investigators and friends of the family grew suspicious: were these tragedies just bad luck or products of malicious intent? “20/20,” in collaboration with Plum Pictures, features contributing anchor Deborah Roberts’ prison interview with Diane Staudte, mother of four and mastermind behind a sinister plot to poison her husband and two children. Diane talks about her relationship with her family and her feelings about the tragic events and alleges that outside influences forced her to falsely confess to the police despite having no evidence to support that claim. The program includes recordings of police interrogations with Diane and her daughter Rachel Staudte, who pleaded guilty to helping her mother in her disturbing scheme to pick the family off one by one. It also features an

interview with Sarah from the ABC News archives about how she is healing after her mother and sister's betrayal. (OAD: 2/25/22)

Friday, August 4, 2023

Growing Up Buttafuoco

Nearly three decades ago, then-17-year-old Amy Fisher — dubbed the “Long Island Lolita” by media — shot Mary Jo Buttafuoco on her front porch following an affair with her husband, Joey Buttafuoco. “20/20” takes a look at the story through the eyes of Mary Jo, Joey and their daughter, Jessie, who was just 9 years old at the time of the shooting in May 1992. Jessie reflects on her journey, including how she learned to understand the tabloid glare that dominated her childhood and how she survived the scrutiny. She also reveals intimate details about life after the incident, including her mom’s excruciating recovery; the family’s move to California to try and escape the media frenzy; her battle with drugs, alcohol and depression; how she turned her life around; and her relationship with her parents. The two-hour program also features Buttafuoco family home videos and the first on-camera interview with confessed accomplice Steven Sleeman, who says Amy hired him to kill Mary Jo. Steven reveals startling details to “20/20” about his role in what he claims was another attempt to kill Mary Jo that shocked his attorney and the Buttafuocos. (OAD: 11/8/19)

Friday, August 11, 2023

Anna Nicole Smith

Years after iconic model, actress and reality star Anna Nicole Smith’s death, “20/20” followed her then 14-year-old daughter, Dannielynn Birkhead, as she visited the most influential places in Anna Nicole’s life with her father, Larry Birkhead. On the journey, they traveled to Mexia, Texas, where Anna Nicole spent part of her childhood. They met her high school friend and saw the places she frequented before becoming famous. While in Los Angeles, they visited several sentimental locations, and Dannielynn saw some of Anna Nicole’s memorabilia from her life and career tucked away in a storage locker following her death. Featuring reporting by “20/20” contributing anchor Deborah Roberts, the two-hour program takes a comprehensive look at Anna Nicole through interviews with those closest to her, as well as material from the ABC News archives. Friday, August 18, 2023

I Now Pronounce You Dead

Just two days before Molly Watson was set to marry James Addie, her love of seven years, a passing motorist found her tragically murdered on a quiet Missouri road. Authorities soon discovered an elaborate and tangled web of lies surrounding James, spun to conceal his biggest secret of all. He was living a double life, both engaged to Watson and married for over 20 years with kids at home. As investigators dug through text messages and other key evidence, the question became: How far would James Addie go to ensure his two lives wouldn’t collide? “20/20” contributing anchor Deborah Roberts sits down with Melanie Addie, James’ ex-wife, who discusses her marriage and how the experience of finding out the truth about her husband shattered the life she once knew. Friday, August 25, 2023

Sincerely, The Happy Face Killer

How did a bizarre confession derail the investigation of the first murder committed by Keith Hunter Jespersen, the notorious “Happy Face Killer,” and allow him to remain on the loose, killing at least seven more women? A two-hour “20/20” reports on how after authorities discovered the body of Taunja Bennett in the Columbia Gorge in 1990, 57-year-old Laverne Pavlinac confessed to the police that she took part in the crime. She provided convincing evidence implicating her and her boyfriend, 39-year-old John Sosnovske, in the murder. They were convicted and sentenced to life in prison. In a shocking twist, Pavlinac’s confession turned out to be false to escape what she described as an abusive relationship with Sosnovske. With reporting by “Nightline” co-anchor Juju Chang, “20/20” dives into how Pavlinac was able to dupe police and features audio from the couple’s confessions, police interviews, and from the hidden microphone installed in Pavlinac’s apartment when she tried to convince Sosnovske that he was involved in the murder. Friday, September 1, 2023

The Wicked

This episode of “20/20” covers the terrifying, violent attack on Payton Leutner, who speaks out after her two friends, Morgan Geyser and Anissa Weier, stabbed her 19 times and left her for dead in the woods of Waukesha, Wisconsin, when she was 12 years old. Preteens at the time, Geyser and Weier claimed they wanted to kill Payton to prove themselves to a mysterious fictitious character known as the Slender Man. “20/20” anchor David Muir interviews Payton about the unspeakable day, the long road of recovery, and her life now. (OAD: 10/25/19).

Friday, September 8, 2023

Long Island Serial Killer

When 23-year-old Shannan Gilbert disappeared in May 2010, the search led police to Gilgo Beach, Long Island, where they found human remains - not of Gilbert, but of four other missing women who had been working as escorts: Melissa Barthelemy, Maureen Brainard-Barnes, Megan Waterman and Amber Costello. Eventually, authorities discovered six other bodies along Ocean Parkway. In an all-new episode, “20/20” contributing anchor Deborah Roberts reports on the dramatic twists and turns in the more than decadelong investigation to find the killer or killers – ranging from a federal investigation into a police chief to the latest forensic technology – until, according to authorities, the latest DNA technology resulted in the arrest of architect, family man and Long Island resident Rex Heuermann. He has been charged with murder in the deaths of Barthelemy, Waterman and Costello, and has pleaded not guilty just this year.

Friday, September 15, 2023

Since You’ve Been Gone

When 17-year-old Alissa Turney disappeared on the last day of her junior year, it initially looked like a classic runaway case — there was even a goodbye note. But over time, authorities grew suspicious that something more sinister had happened. A new “20/20” explores the recent twists and turns of the case, including a false confession from a serial killer, the discovery of pipe bombs, and a murder trial acquittal, building on original ABC News reporting from when Alissa disappeared in 2001.

Friday, September 22, 2023

Taken in the Night

On a fall night in 1993, an intruder entered the home of 12-year-old Polly Klaas and kidnapped her during a sleepover with two friends while her mother slept in the next room. A new “20/20” reports on how the bold kidnapping spurred not only the small town of Petaluma, California, but the entire nation into action and explores the lasting impact of her case on the justice system, kidnapping investigation protocol, and much more.

Happily Never After

ABC News’ award-winning program “20/20” returns for its 46th season with Peabody and Emmy®-Award winning journalist Deborah Roberts joining David Muir as co-anchors of Friday’s No. 1 newsmagazine across the board. The two-hour season premiere “Happily Never After” features the shocking story of the October 2020 murder of Dallas-based American Airlines director Jamie Faith. Faith was shot seven times by a masked gunman at close range in front of his wife, Jennifer, while taking their dog on a daily morning walk. At first, authorities have little evidence to go on other than a mysterious black pickup truck fleeing the scene. Was it a robbery gone wrong, an act of revenge, or could there be something even more sinister at play? In a case that shocked even the most seasoned detectives, the episode follows the investigation uncovering a double life, a grieving widow with something to hide, and one big lie that no one saw coming. “GMA3” co-anchor and ABC News correspondent Eva Pilgrim reports.
