## PUBLIC AFFAIRS RELATED PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

### **Nebraska Workforce** – Monday thru Friday 10:10am

A two minute program aimed at helping area citizens learn of employment opportunities across the listening area. The program offers listeners guidance on openings and also local job training events and offers educational opportunities to enhance employment.

### **Chamber Chatter** – Monday thru Friday 10:25am

The five minute program produced by the Columbus Chamber of Commerce provides listeners with information on community events and Columbus Chamber of Commerce information every weekday. The program offers information on educational opportunities, healthcare issues, community involvement events, and charity events.

### **KTTT Community News** – Monday thru Friday 6:20am, 7:20am, 8:20am, 9:20am

KTTT Community News is a two minute program dedicated to informing the public on the latest issues that affect them personally, affect their community, and affect the state. The program provides updates on issues impacting local and state government, education, healthcare, tourism, charities, organizations and the environment
