Quarterly Issues Report

First Quarter 2022 (January-March)

WFOY continues its efforts to enhance the information needs of citizens in the city of St Augustine and others within its broadcast area.

This is accomplished by airing numerous programs and messages containing informational, public service and civically related materials that are of use to those listeners.

The following is a partial list of such program elements aired during this quarter. Each program element listed is accompanied by a brief description of the format and general content. This is a list of some of the more significant community issues addressed for the station during the quarter specified. This list is by no means complete, nor is the order in which these issues appear intended to imply any degree of proximity or significance of the issues.

- *The St Johns County Morning News*

A live program broadcast each weekday morning between 8 and 9 am. The host of this program presents local news from St Johns County, along with CBS National news at the top of each hour, and Florida Network news at the bottom of each hour. A community calendar segment announcing community related items is mentioned once during each hour. In-Studio broadcasts include interviews with elected and other community officials, business leaders, non-profit executives, and others. Local News and Traffic reports are also broadcast at least once during each hour.

- *Local News Broadcasts*

A local newscast is compiled and aired during the St Johns County Morning News. These newscasts are prepared by in-house staff. The frequency and brevity of these broadcasts are dynamic and subject to change in order that they may meet community needs when there is an urgent need to keep listeners informed (Hurricanes, weather anomalies, Fire danger, etc).

- *Local Sports Broadcasts*

A local sport broadcast is aired each weekday afternoon featuring highlights and stories from local, regional, state and national sports. The show includes in-depth discussions with high school coaches, players, officials, alumni and fans.

Live coverage of St Augustine High School Football Games (third and fourth quarter)
