Community programming is aired every hour around the half hour for 3-7 minutes every day in response to the issues and concerns from the people in our listening area. These programs run twenty-two times a day, and include not only key issues of the community, but all issues regarding public announcements of churches, clubs, schools, and civic organizations.

Community programming airs a minimum of 75 minutes per day totaling over 37 hours per month. Also, in addition to a community-programming segment, public service announcements are mixed in throughout each hour of the broadcast day.
