	Type Of Recruitment Initiative (Menu Selection)	Brief Description Of Activity
1	Sponsor an event/program for or on behalf of an educational institution	On April 22, 2022, five students and a teacher from Jefferson Community College came to the station for a tour and an inside look at television broadcasting. Students watched a live newscast and discussed career paths and job functions with SEU employees.
2	Host an internship program	From February to August 2022, our SEU hosted an internship program that allowed college students to gain real-world broadcasting experience by working directly on our newscasts. We ran following internship programs during this reporting year:
		Journalism internships. Four students from SUNY Oswego and Utica College participated in internships learning the basics of television journalism from news gathering to on-air presentation and everything in between.
		Weather internship. A U.S. Army soldier preparing to transition back to civilian life participated in an internship program with our weather department. The soldier learned about meteorology and forecasting techniques and we helped her develop her resume tape.
3	Participate in an event/program for or on behalf of an educational institution	On March 2, 2022, our SEU participated in the SUNY Oswego Spring Career Fair. SEU staff spoke to students interested in a career path in the broadcasting industry and also conducted interviews.
4	Participate in an event/program for or on behalf of a community organization	On May 26, 2022, the Jefferson Lewis Workplace Development Board hosted the 6 th Annual Career Jam, a career information event, at the Watertown Municipal Area. The event was held at the Municipal Arena in Watertown for students interested in communications and media careers.
		Students were able to ask questions about careers in the television industry as well as participate in

		hands-on activities that included mock newscasts with students portraying themselves as anchors and reporters. SEU staff set up a teleprompter for students to read from and then provided feedback.
5	Participate in a career fair	On September 27, 2022, our SEU participated in the 10 th Annual Jefferson-Lewis Job Fair held at the Hilton Garden Inn. During the event SEU staff spoke to participants about current job openings at the SEU, answered questions from job seekers, and collected resumes.
6	Participate in a career fair	On October 12, 2022, our SEU participated in the SUNY Oswego Career and Internship Fair. During the event SEU staff spoke to participants about current job openings at the SEU, answered questions from job seekers, and collected resumes.
7	Participate in an event/program sponsored by an educational institution	On November 9, 2022, one of our MMJ/Reporters was a guest speaker at the Copenhagen Central School Career Day. She presented to three groups of high school students about what it is like to be a reporter, what kind of skills a person should have to be a reporter, and the kind of education a student might need to pursue a career as a reporter. Our MMJ/Reporter prepared a Powerpoint and video to show students the range of things a reporter can do. She also brought in her camera equipment so students could see first-hand what it's like to be an MMJ. Students were also able to ask questions.
