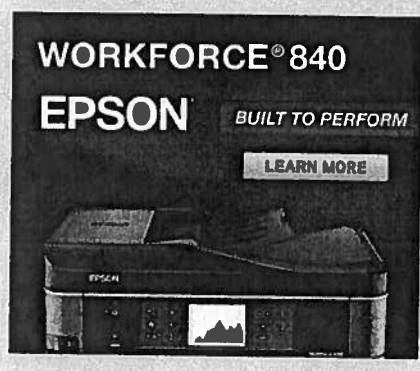

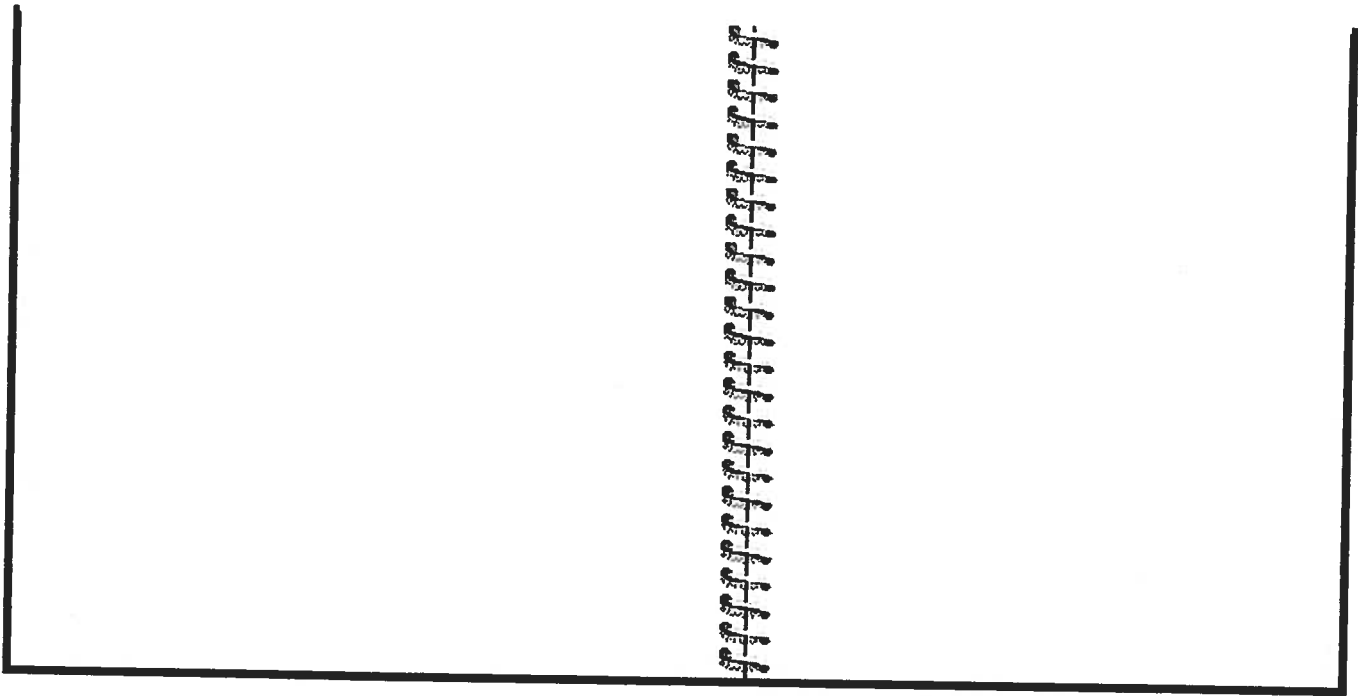

1. Leadership
 - a. Lead by example. Put in the time and effort to be successful and create an environment that fosters success. Know your station, the competition, and the market in detail.
 - b. Participate in station functions. Be visible with staff, community and industry groups.
 - c. Anticipate problems. Set strategies and expectations and see them through to completion.
2. Communication, Relationships
 - a. Meet with agency and client decision makers at least three times per week.
 - b. Maintain weekly communication with national rep GSM and team managers. Travel to key rep offices at least three times per year. Hold quarterly review/strategy sessions.
 - c. Conduct at least two sales meetings per week. One informational meeting led by the GSM focusing on sales training, strategy, inventory, research, and programming. The other, led by the LSMs, focusing on market competitive, pricing, and specific goals.
 - d. Provide your staff with accurate ratings estimates and program schedule at least two months before the start of a quarter. Update rate and inventory information weekly or more if necessary. Clearly articulate areas that need special attention and focus.

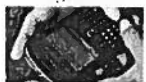

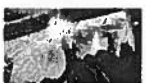

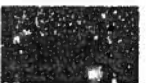
