This veterans cemetery will have a total of 1,777 burial spots across 10 acres.

FREE SPAY NEUTER CLINIC IN ST. LANDRY PARISH

BISSELL Pet Foundation (BPF) is sponsoring its first, free spay/neuter clinic for dogs in the St. Landry Parish community with a goal of sterilizing approximately 300 pets. Aiming to prevent unwanted litters from homelessness, this four-day clinic will take place at the YamBaLee Building on February 13-16.

To participate, residents must visit the office of St. Landry Parish Animal Control to officially sign-up.

In order for a dog to qualify, Opelousas residents and their pets must first attend a wellness clinic on January 30 at the YamBaLee Building anytime between 8:30am and 6pm to attain the required vaccinations (distemper and rabies) and a microchip (also free of charge). The benefits of these clinics combined equate to a \$350 value.

Attendees will be asked to show proof of residency with a personal driver's license or state ID. If your pet is currently experiencing health issues, this clinic will not be able to accommodate you. Please consider calling to make an appointment at your local veterinarian.
