BHTV License, LLC (“Big Horn”), licensee of KGWC-TV, Casper, Wyoming (Facility ID No. 63177) and KGWR-TV, Rock Springs, Wyoming (Facility ID No. 63170), hereby responds to your EEO Audit letter dated March 21, 2022. KGWR-TV is operated as a satellite of KGWC-TV, as is commonly owned station KGWL-TV, Lander, Wyoming (Facility ID No. 63132) and accordingly, all three stations are operated as a single employment unit (the “Unit”). Big Horn acquired the Stations’ licenses on June 1, 2020 pursuant to a long-form assignment application (BALCDT-20191015AAU) and accordingly, Big Horn’s responses relate to the time period beginning on that date.


The Unit currently has fewer than five full-time employees; therefore, it is not required to have an EEO recruitment program. Big Horn’s current full-time employees at the Unit are a Master Control Tech regularly scheduled to work 40 hours per week and an Account Executive regularly scheduled to work 40 hours per week.

There are no pending or resolved complaints involving the Unit since Big Horn became the Stations’ licensee.

In accordance with Section 73.3527(e)(11) of the Commission’s Rules, a copy of the EEO audit letter and this response are being placed in the Public Inspection File for each Station.
