

Certificate of Compliance

The Massachusetts Broadcasters Association (the "Association") hereby certifies that the following broadcast station, NWFX FM (the "Station"), located in Southbridge, MA, (i) recently participated in the Massachusetts Broadcasters Association Alternative Broadcast Inspection Program (the "ABIP Program"), which is maintained by the Association pursuant to an agreement (the "ABIP Agreement") between the Association and the Enforcement Bureau of the Federal Communications Commission (the "Bureau"), and (ii) has successfully completed that Program.

Accordingly, pursuant to that Agreement, the Association hereby issues this original, executed and valid Certificate of Compliance to the Station on this

12 day of October, 2004.

It is contemplated that this Certificate of Compliance will remain in full force and effect for a three year period to, and including, October 12, 2007.

The benefits accruing to the Station as the holder of this valid Certificate of Compliance are spelled out in the ABIP Agreement dated as of August 15, 2003, by and between the Association and the Bureau. The Station is solely responsible for insuring that it has fully complied with the requirements of the ABIP Agreement in all applicable respects, including but not limited to the requirement that the Station publicly display the Certificate of Compliance as contemplated under paragraph 4.d. of the ABIP Agreement. The failure of the Station to so comply will undermine the validity of the Certificate of Compliance. Furthermore, it is understood that the ABIP Agreement governs the relationship between the Station and the Bureau as it relates to this matter.
