Supplemental Recruitment Initiatives.

I. Internship Program. The Employment Unit internship program established in 2001 affords local students from area school districts and Sam Houston State University students in the departments of Radio/Television and Marketing the opportunity to serve as interns at the stations.

The Employment Unit is available for students referred by school district instructors or personnel at Sam Houston State University interested in learning more about a career in broadcasting. Interns will typically spend nine to twelve hours per week at the stations or on location with

station personnel during live broadcasts, gaining a broad and general overview of the radio broadcast industry. Interns can participate in discussions and planning for music programming, promotions, and public service, as well as hands on operator experience if they so desire. Upon successful completion of the internship students earn credit toward their degree or credit for various high school programs, i.e. Job Shadowing and D.E.C.A. The intern is under the direct supervision of one of the station's program directors, and works with the entire programming staff, and also has interaction with the sales and administrative staffs. The internship initiative has resulted in the hiring of some of its participants on a part-time basis, to allow them to continue learning and gaining experience in the broadcast industry. Sam Houston State University did not refer any students in 2019. The internship program was paused in early 2020 due to health and safety protocols related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

II. Participation in Job/Career Fairs. The Employment Unit attended career fairs to distribute literature and answer questions about careers in broadcasting. These included:

1. The Huntsville ISD Job/Career Fair on April 6, 2019.
2. The Sam Houston State University (SHSU) Spring Career Fair on April 11, 2019.
3. The Walker County College & Career Fair on October 1, 2019.
4. The SHSU Fall Career & Internship Fair on October 16, 2019.

III. Participation in Community Educational and Scholarship-Related Events.

1. HEH Communications supported and promoted the Walker/Trinity County branch of the NAACP Baker/Jones Scholarship and Recognition Banquet on March 30, 2019, an event providing 20 scholarships to local African-American students.
2. HEH Communications supported and promoted the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC) Amigo Award Scholarship Banquet on February 9, 2020. The scholarships provide educational opportunities for Hispanic students from the local Huntsville community.
